參加亞太農業研究機構聯盟(APAARI)舉辦強化區域農業資訊體系專家諮議會議報告

壹、前 言

有鑑於資訊科技產品及網際網路的蓬勃發展,全球各領域均在探討如何應用資訊網路科技促進知識蓄積與分享,進而激發創新,突破發展限制。因此,亞太農業研究機構聯盟(APAARI)舉辦強化區域農業資訊體系專家諮議會議,邀集會員代表及一些非政府組織代表共同探討資訊通訊科技 (Information Communication Technology, ICT) 在農業研究發展上所扮演的角色,並藉以了解亞太平洋區域研究網路的狀況,該次會議於九十二年十二月一日至三日在泰國曼谷舉行。

參加此次會議之國家代表計有日本、台灣(中華民國)、大韓民 國、菲律賓、印度、越南、泰國、馬來西亞、孟加拉、尼泊爾、新喀 里多尼亞、巴基斯坦、巴布亞鈕幾內亞、澳洲、斐濟、伊朗及西薩摩 亞等十七個國家。此外,有亞洲理工學院(AIT, Asian Institute of Technology)、亞洲蔬菜研究發展中心(AVRDC,Asian Vegetable Research and Development Center)、國際職務遺傳資源所(IPGRI, International Plant Genetic Resources Institute)、國際乾旱農 業研究中心(ICARDA,International Center for Agricultural Research in the Dry Areas)、國際半乾旱熱帶作物研究所(ICRISAT, International Crop Research Institute for Semi Arid Tropics) 世界漁業中心 (World Fish Center)、國家農業研究國際服務中心 (ISNAR, International Service for National Agricultural Research)、國際玉米與小麥研究中心 (International Maize and Wheat Improvement Center)、國際稻米研究所(IRRI, International Rice Research Institute)、亞太地區養殖漁業中心網路(NACA, Network of Aquaculture Centers in Asia-Pacific)、亞太地區種 子協會(Asia-Pacific Seed Association)、 亞太森林研究機構協 聯盟 (Asia-Pacific Association of Forestry Research Institutions)、國際鹽分地帶農業研究中心 (ICBA, International Center for Biosaline Agriculture)、聯合國潮濕熱帶區粗穀類、 豆類、根莖類、塊莖類作物研究發展中心 (UN ESCAP CGPRT)、網路 協調機構 (Network Coordinators)、國際待開發作物研究中心 (International Center for Underutilized Crops)、全球農業論 壇 (GFAR, Global Forum on Agricultural Research)、聯合國糧農 組織 (FAO, Food and Agriculture Organization) 等十九個仲會員 出席。

我國由行政院農業委員會企劃處林科長貞出席會議。我國代表於十一月三十日出發,當天即抵達會場,並由 APAARI 秘書 Dr. Sahdev Singhe 告知次日會議我國代表的座位席次,桌上擺有座席卡架,上面寫明 COA. Council of

Agriculture (Taiwan)。但第二天早上我國代表到達會場卻發現前 一天寫明我國代表單位的座席卡架不見了,於是立即向 Dr. Sahdev Singhe 詢問我國代表應坐何處,他竟然告知在旁邊沒有座席卡架的 位子隨便坐,我國代表發覺與他理論無用,即刻向 APAARI 執行秘書 Dr. R. S. Paroda 告知我國代表座席卡架不見,他說他的同事弄錯 以為我國代表不出席,於是他請人去處理此事。結果他的同事拿來 一個空白座席卡架,上貼一張白紙打上 COA,我國代表即時抗議為 何沒寫上 Council of Agriculture (Taiwan), 他竟說都只寫明單 位名稱,我國代表立即反駁為何泰國、越南、菲律賓等國家代表的 座席卡架均有寫明代表單位的全銜及國家名稱,只有非政府組織才 寫明單位名稱縮寫。因會議已開始,我國代表只好自己在座席卡架 上寫明 Council of Agriculture (Taiwan)。待中場休息再向 APAARI 主席 Dr. Mutsuo Iwamoto 說明我國是 APAARI 的會員國之一,我國 一直對該組織負起會員國的責任,為何會遭受如此不平等的待遇, 他隨即告訴 Dr. Paroda 不可如此對待我國代表,要求他們立刻將我 國代表的座席卡架找出來,過一會兒即有人找出我國代表正式的座 席卡架,並放置我國代表的面前。

在 APAARI 第七屆年會已爭取獲得 2004 年第八屆年會將在台北舉行,但一直未再得到 APAARI 秘書處的確認,因此,我國代表銜命在這次諮詢會議中詢問第八屆年會相關事宜,當 12 月 1 日向 Dr. Paroda 提及第八屆年會決定何時在台北舉行,他竟然回答還未確定是否在台北舉行,必須待 12 月 4 日早上 APAARI 指導委員會召開會議時再討論,於是我國代表只好將國際處事先準備好我國舉辦第八屆年會的說帖交給指導委員會的委員們,同時拜託對我國友善的泰國、越南及日本代表給予支持,終於在 12 月 4 日會議中拍案確定第八屆年會將於 2004 年 12 月 1 日至 4 日在台北舉行。

貳、會議重要議題及決議

本次會議由與會各國代表報告各國農業資訊化情況,會員國中以台灣、日本及南韓在農業資訊的軟硬體建設及應用推廣均居領先地位,尤其我國農業資訊發展的深廣度及通訊網路的普及更是令與會代表印象深刻。

亞太農業研究機構聯盟自 1999 年開始發展亞太農業研究資訊

系統(APARIS Asia Pacific Agricultural Research Information System),至2002年完成第一期工程,包括七項主要功能,分述如下:

- 提供管理資訊系統工具一建立區域研究網路資料庫、農業研究發展計畫資料庫及農業研究發展指標資料庫、每日農業新聞;
- 2. 提供有關農業研究發展及資訊通訊管理之區域事件訊息—如亞太區域召開有關農業研究發展及資訊通訊管理等議題之會議或訓練活動;
- 3. 張貼農業研究科學性刊物;
- 4. 提供農業研究發展社群便於對話的電子論壇,目前有三項電子論壇,分別為亞太區域資訊及訓練需求、連接 EGFAR NARS 論壇及國家農業研究體系
- 5. (NARS, National Agricultural Research System) 會員所提出特定題目之論壇。
- 6. 提供入口服務,作為區域研究網路(RRNs, Regional Research Networks)入口,連結亞太地區具 NARS 機構的網站,成為有關農業研究區域性特定主題網站的入口。
- 7. 強化亞太區域農業研究發展知識網路,促使各區域研究網路的資 訊資源易於使用,啟動農業研究發展某些特殊領域知識網路研發 之先軀計畫。
- 8. 提供有關 APAARI 的一般訊息,如 APAARI 的出版品及所製作的光碟影片,連結其他農業研究發展機構出版品。第一期已完成 APARIS 的系統架構。

因此,於2002年十月 APAARI 組成第二次資訊通訊技術專家顧問群討論該系統未來的發展,並於2003年四月開會決議未來發展方向如下:

- 1. 在 APAARI 網站建立一個區域農業專家庫 (REAL, Regional Agricultural Expert Locator),此專家庫包含每位專家的基本資料,但為機密資料不公開,同時建立各專家所執行的計畫、發表的研究文獻及報告、參與專業的各項活動。並提供查詢功能,但使用者必須申請帳號。
- 2. 簡化 APAARI 網站的入口功能,連結 APAARI 會員組織的伺服主機, 針對每一個網頁進行全文檢索,針對被選擇的檔案取得所需資 訊,儲存資料市集成為一個內部資料庫,以減少搜尋時間。並將 搜尋結果以標準的 XML 格式呈現。
- 3. 印製農業研究發展資訊資源手冊,由 APAARI、FAO、ISNAR 及 CABI 合作編製,讓使用者可存放在個人電腦中便於參考,第一版只包 含免費可使用的資訊資源,內容包括網站內容簡介、使用對象及

使用步驟。

- 4. 評估 NARS 會員對資訊通訊技術需求,以提供農業研究發展決策者 訂定 ICT 採用模式、數位資訊的建立與管理等工作。
- 5. 更新 APARIS 網站,確定所連結網站的有效性。
- 6. APARIS 將連結 FAO、GFAR、ISNAR 及其他區域或國家所發展的農業資訊系統。

亞太區域人口近35億,佔全世界人口數55%,從事農業人口佔 57%,農地面積佔全球農業面積 32%,但貧窮人口佔 40%,且面對飢餓 與食物安全、人口及農村變遷、農地分割及減少、自然資源惡化、農 業研究發展投資經費下降、以及全球化等重要問題,而據估計至2003 年,全球穀物需求量為957百萬噸,東亞需求量佔27.27%,南亞需 求量佔19.12%,因此,第二次的綠色革命是必要的,以滿足因人口 增加而需更多的食物,所以,將生物技術整合應用於傳統農業會增加 產量並滿足消費者的需求。但也因而衍生該類農產品對人類及動物健 康安全性評估的問題。於是 FAO 及 APAARI 從 2002 年 3 月 21 日至 23 日在曼谷召開亞太地區生物技術專家諮詢會議,評估農業生物技術對 於增加農業生產力及利潤的潛力,同時考量生物技術的採用對農民及 消費者的利益,能否確保食品的安全性。與會者都認為目前生物技術 的研發門檻高且花費大,必須公私部門共同合作從事生物技術的研 發,故建議成立亞太農業生物技術協會(APCoAB, Asia Pacific Consortium on Agricultural Biotechnology),以有效整合大家的 力量,利用有限資源,促使應用生物科技達成農業永續發展。

該協會將與亞太區域的大學及其他機構合作舉辦有關生物資訊、新分子技術、生物安全等課題之短期課程或研習會,以強化研究人員、政府官員及農民的知識;並與非政府組織、農民及 ISAAA、 IARCs、GFAR、ARIs 等組織合作舉辦公共論壇,促成政府訂定相關政策、一致的標準。同時舉行兩年一次有關農業生物技術的研討會。

亞太農業生物技術協會是一獨立的組織,有一小型指導委員會負責協會的運轉,並有政策規劃及督導之責。該次會議報告該協會架構時,已將台灣列為會員國之一。

在該次諮詢會議亦討論如何發展老師及學生們所需要的電子化課程(E-courses),目前先開發英文版的課程,未來再翻譯成亞太各國的當地語言。同時倡導亞太區域農業相關資訊有效流通,並強化農業網站的內涵,增加國家級、區域性及全球性的農業資訊系統的開發資金。

參、心得與建議

目前我國已完成農漁會、水利會等農業相關組織的網路建設,並

將其行政業務導入電子化,同時開發產銷班經營管理系統免費提供產銷班使用,期使他們利用資訊科技導入企業化管理,以掌握市場資訊、降低管理成本,提升經營效率,了解自身利基所在,進而能獲得收益。去年我國又積極建構農業知識管理應用資訊平台,期望由本會所屬研究單位同仁將農業相關知識匯入該體系,促使農業知識能會自由快速分享,以激發創新研發的能量。我國農業資訊方面的建設育品上快速分享,以激發創新研發的能量。我國農業資訊方面的建設資訊,但更需藉由農業工作者充分利用台灣資訊科技的進步與網際網路的普及促成我國農業發展展現新的生機,藉其的路道導我國優質且安全的農業,以拓展農業產品通路,並擴增農業的產值。而且,唯有我們的表現優異,拉大我國農業發展與其他國家的距離,才能在國際佔一席之地,參加國際會議以展與其他國家的在國際所面臨的困境更需要靠優越的成果讓別人不敢忽視台灣的存在,同時要鼓勵國人排除萬難出席國際會議以展現國人努力產生的豐碩結果,讓國際視聽體認我國實質的存在。

An Update on Recent APAARI Activities (2002-2003)

Introduction

Asia Pacific Association of Agricultural Research institutions (APAARI), established in 1990 as an apolitical, non-profit and neutral forum of National Agricultural Research Systems (NARS) in the region, aims to strengthen the research capabilities of NARS and promote experience sharing among them in order to alleviate poverty, increase agricultural productivity and resource use, protect/conserve the environment and improve sustainability. Besides the regional NARS, several International Agricultural Research Centers (IARCs) and CGIAR Institutes are its associate members.

The primary focus of APAARI objectives is to enhance exchange of scientific and technical know-how and information in agricultural research for development; assist in strengthening research capability of member institutions and promote cross linkages among national, regional and international research organizations. APAARI, in consultation with its stakeholders, has developed a long-term perspective plan and strategies to address relevant issues, including regional collaboration, networking of research programmes; HRD; policy advocacy; resource generation and publication enhancement.

APAARI Mission

"To promote the development of national agricultural research systems in the Asia-Pacific region through facilitation of intra-regional, inter-institutional and international cooperation"

Functions

- Convene General Assembly to develop Policies, Priorities and Programmes; Organize working groups, meetings, seminars, expert consultations on regional issues;
- Collect, collate and disseminate research information; maintain links with agencies/institutions/organizations engaged in similar activities within and outside the region;
- Promote collaborative research among member institutions; Partnership with CGIAR/IARCs, ARIs, GFAR, Regional, Sub-Regional Fora and the Private Sector

A brief Report of APAARI activities undertaken since the GFAR 2002 meeting is as follows:

1. Expert Consultations/Meetings

1.1 Meetings Held

The Seventh General Assembly of APAARI and Expert Consultation on Strengthening of Research Partnerships Through Networks and Consortia

The Seventh General Assembly of APAARI and Expert Consultation on Strengthening of Research Partnerships Through Networks and Consortia were held at Penang, Malaysia from 2 - 4 December 2002. There were about 60 participants representing member NARS, associate members, ARIs, the Private sector, supporting organizations such as FAO, GFAR and special invitees. The Expert Consultation had five technical sessions and Plenary session. Reports on important regional networks such as CLAN, CORRA/INGER, RWC, TAMNET, GoFAR, PGR, COGENT, BAPNET were presented by respective network coordinators/representatives. The collaborative research activities involving the private sector were presented by APSA and MONSANTO. An exclusive session was held on ICT networks with speakers from FAO, GFAR, CABI, ASTI and APAARI. APAARI looks ahead to strengthen networks further keeping in view the suggestions that have emerged from dialogue among stakeholders, such as: Lead NARS to work more towards networks hub-role; Involve NARS in the development and not only research partnerships; Vitalize sick networks or close the non-performing networks; Identify and initiate new networks, such as: a) IWMI's Challenge Programme on Food and Water; b) The Asia-Pacific Consortium on Agricultural Biotechnology (APCoAB), and c) The Inter-Regional Network on Cotton involving AARINENA, APAARI and CAC-RF.

The expert consultation was followed by 7th General Assembly of APAARI on 4 December 2002. A new Executive Committee of APAARI for the period 2003-2004 was unanimously elected by the General Assembly and the members reviewed the progress made by APAARI in its various activities.

Meeting to discuss Establishment of Asia-Pacific Consortium for Agricultural Biotechnology (APCoAB)

FAO-RAP and APAARI, on 4th April 2003 at Bangkok, organized a meeting to discuss establishment of Asia-Pacific Consortium on Agricultural Biotechnology (APCoAB). There were about 25 participants representing regional NARS, IARCs, CG Centers, NGOs, foundations, and the private sector. Based on meeting deliberations, the following specific recommendations emerged that were endorsed by the participants:

- The participants recognized the efforts of both FAO and APAARI for having developed the APCoAB concept through consultation involving various stakeholders, and they further appreciated the initiative of APAARI in putting together a very good Concept Note on APCoAB and for having organized this meeting jointly with FAO Regional Office, Bangkok;
- APCoAB to move ahead as a neutral platform for the stakeholders to exchange views, ideas and knowledge in the field of agricultural biotechnology;
- Initial focus to be on some achievable objectives after further prioritization of APCoAB activities;
- Beside APAARI, active support of FAÓ, CGIAR (ISNAR), GFAR, ADB, World Bank, the private sector, prominent foundations, and other key global donor agencies be sought for the establishment of APCoAB. Subsequently, NARS could also be approached for their support as well in the form of membership contributions;
- An APCoAB Steering/Advisory Committee, consisting of one representative from each APAARI, FAO, NARS, CG Centers, the Private Sector, NGOs, and the Foundations be formed that can guide on pragmatic constitutional and legal structure of the Consortium;
- Recommendations and proceedings of the meeting should be sent to all NARS associated with APAARI, who approved the APCoAB idea during APAARI Expert Consultation on ARD Networks and Consortia, held in Penang, Malaysia in order to apprise them of these further developments; and
- Finally, APAARI to continue with its efforts to move forward in establishing APCoAB and take up the matter further with all concerned organizations.

Meeting of the APARIS Support Group

The meeting on April 3, 2003 was a follow up initiative to formalize the bilateral cooperation between APAARI and the members of its support group in the area of ICT, including FAO-RAP, GFAR, ISNAR, and AIT. The final recommendations of the meeting included followings:

- APAARI and FAO-RAP representatives to discuss and develop a proposal for collaborative activities

to be considered by FAO-RAP and APAARI management.

- APAARI and ISNAR to develop a MoU for future collaboration between APAARI and ISNAR, particularly for the ICT need assessment activities, ISNAR's support for ICT capacity building in the Asia Pacific region, and possible integration of ISNAR's information resources those of APARIS.
- APAARI and AIT to finalize the arrangements for proposed APAARI ICT workshop at AIT in December 2003 with major support from GFAR, and AIT's help in APAARI web site development and promotion.
- APAARI, ISNAR and FAO-RAP to jointly develop a guide for useful ARD information resources that can be distributed to APAARI members.
- APAARI to move forward with the development of (a) a simplified gateway function with the help of ISNAR, FAO, AIT, and CABI, and (b) a regional agricultural expert locator function with the collaboration of FAO-RAP.
- APAARI, in collaboration with all its support group members, to develop a framework for a project proposal to be submitted to ADB, the World Bank, or some other donor organizations.

Meeting of APCoAB Support Group

In order to accelerate the process for establishment of Asia-Pacific Consortium of Agricultural Biotechnology (APCoAB), for which APAARI General Assembly in December 2002 had given its endorsement, a meeting of the APCoAB's primary donor/support group was convened on 21 July, 2003 at Bangkok. The meeting participants included representatives from FAO-RAP, APAARI, ICRISAT, ISNAR, ACIAR, and Monsanto Corporation and discussed the APCoAB issues such as its steering committee formation, priority activities and programmes, funding support, location of the APCoAB secretariat, and potential collaborators. The outcomes of the meeting included:

- APCoAB steering committee to include APAARI represented by two NARS members (one APAARI Chairman himself and one NARS leader from any developing country); FAO represented by Dr. Arturo Martinez of AGPS (as per FAO communication); CG Centers (ICRISAT, IRRI, and ISNAR on rotation-basis); GFAR represented by Dr. Ola Smith, Executive Secretary; Private Sector represented by Dr. Eric Johnson of Monsanto; ISAAA represented by Mr. Randy Hautea; CSO/NGO/Farmers initially represented by Mr. Roel Ravanera of ANGOC; and APCoAB Coordinator to serve as Member Secretary
- Priority activities of APCoAB to include research partnership, information dissemination, capacity building, public awareness, and policy advocacy
- APAARI to present these recommendations to its Executive Committee and seek further funding support from international, regional, private and public organizations

1.2. Current Meetings

From 1-4 December 2003 APAARI will organize three meetings at Asian Institute of Technology, Thailand for which invitations have been sent to various APAARI stakeholders and several participants have confirmed their attendance. These events will include:

Expert Consultation on ICT in ARD

With partial financial support from GFAR, this expert consultation will be organized from December 1-3, 2003 to strengthen the regional agricultural information system and national information nodal points, and further identify specific programmes to enhance the role of ICT in ARD.

• Status of Regional Research Networks and Special Session on Establishment of APCoAB On 3rd December 2003, a special session on establishment of APCoAB will review the current status of this initiative and discuss the future road map. A special session on 2nd December 2003 will discuss the status of APAARI supported research network and ways to further strengthen them.

Seventh APAARI Executive Committee Meeting

The seventh APAARI Executive Committee meeting will review 2003 APAARI activities, membership status and audited accounts, finalize 2004 work plan, and decide on establishment of APCoAB.

2. APAARI ICT Activities

APAARI Homepage

The APAARI home page (www.apaari.org) has been improved and further enriched with new information and links. The site now provides useful information on agricultural R&D activities in the region such as seminars, symposia, conferences etc., performs gateway function and serves as a portal to regional research networks. The objective of this component of APARIS is to facilitate access to information resources on the internet, both through search engines and by facilitating access to web sites of institutions that work in ARD and to web sites that are related to specialized topics of ARD. This is only a portal service, and not a database. Access to the web sites of the NARS institutions in the region is being facilitated. Some of the new features on the site include information on NARS database and links to other regional and global institutions. The improved site has features for e-discussion among national information nodal points. Most of the APAARI publications are now available on the website for download

APARIS Update

Two new functions, gateway and regional agricultural expert locator (RAEL), are currently being developed to make APARIS more useful to the agricultural researchers of the region. The gateway function will be able to perform keyword-based search on the ARD information resources available in the region and the RAEL function will maintain a database of agricultural experts. Through this function the interested agricultural experts will be able to log-on to APARIS and upload/update their information including a list of their publications.

MoU between APAARI and ISNAR

APAARI and ISNAR developed an MOU to undertake joint programmes in the area of ICT and an action plan is being prepared. Under this MoU, APAARI and ISNAR are currently developing a guide of useful ARD information resources and collecting information on the status of ICT in ARD which will be published as a benchmark report for the region.

FAORAP-APAARI Collaboration on ICT Activities

FAO-RAP and APAARI representatives have jointly developed a work plan to promote ICT in ARD. The specific activities in the work plan include demonstration of FAO's ICT tools to the national information nodal points of APAARI and publication of the benchmark report on the status and progress of ICT in ARD in the Asia-Pacific region.

3. Publications

APAARI brought out the following publications during the period under report and these were widely distributed particularly for the use of member NARS:

Newsletters

Two issues of APAARI Newsletter (December-2002 and June -2003) were published timely and widely circulated. Electronic versions of the newsletters have also been posted on APAARI web site.

Proceedings of Expert Consultations

The Proceedings of the following two Expert Consultations were published and distributed widely. These are also posted on APAARI homepage:

- Proceedings of the Seventh General Assembly of APAARI and Expert Consultation on Strengthening of Research Partnerships through Networks and Consortia
- Proceedings of the ICT Expert Consultation on the Development of Second Phase of APARIS

Success Stories

- A new Success Story on the "Control of Newcastle Disease in Village Chickens Using Thermotolerant Vaccines", the nineteenth in the series by APAARI, has recently been published and circulated to all APAARI members and some key ARD contacts for its wider dissemination. The success story is also being put on the APAARI web site.
- Another Success Story on "Biological Control of Insect Pests in India" is presently being edited for its publication soon.
- Revised Constitution of APAARI has also been published and circulated. It has also been posted on APAARI website.

4. Membership enhancement (New Members/Associate members/ Reciprocal Associate Members)

Several national, regional and international organizations expressed interest in becoming members, associate members of APAARI. These are:

- APSA, NACA, APAFRI, and AARINENA have joined as associate members and have also accepted APAARI as their associate member on reciprocal basis.
- Crop & Food Research, PB 4704, Christchurch, New Zealand

NARS of China and Indonesia are also being pursued for joining APAARI.

5. Support to NARS and Networks

Support to CLAN

In order to widen the network activities of CLAN, a network of ICRISAT, to also cover crops such as soybean, mungbean and lentil in partnership with AVRDC and ICARDA, APAARI ICRISAT have jointly decided to organize a steering committee meeting at Hyderabad in November, 2003. ICRISAT, ICARDA and AVRDC have, in principal, agreed to collaborate and would initiate specific activities under the network to support APAARI member NARS in Asia-Pacific region.

■ TAMNET Revival

APAARI, in cooperation with FAO and APSA, has facilitated the revitalization of the network TAMNET, and has provided support for the distribution of hybrid maize trial seeds to the participating members in the network.

CORRA

CORRA network presented its activity report in the APAARI organized expert consultation on Strengthening of Research Partnerships through Networks and Consortia.

GoFAR

GoFAR coordinator presented an activity report in the APAARI organized expert consultation on Strengthening of Research Partnerships through Networks and Consortia. APAARI extended complete funding support to delegates from Philippines, Vietnam, Bangladesh, and Nepal to participate in the third meeting of GoFAR at the World Fish Center, Penang, Malaysia from 3-5 November 2002.

Inter-Regional Cotton Research Network

APAARI contributed a sum of USD5,000 to the Inter-Regional Cotton Research Network facilitated and coordinated by Cotton Research Institute, AREO, Iran. The network partners include: AARINENA, APAARI, CAC, GFAR, ICARDA and AREO.

6. Participation in meetings/workshops/conferences

- APAARI was represented by Dr. Patricio Faylon of PCAARD in the Sixth Annual Meeting of CORRA held in Beijing, China from 14-15 September 2002.
- Dr. Raj Paroda, APAARI Executive Secretary attended the Inter-Regional Cotton Workshop held in Teheran (Iran) on 12-13 October 2002.
- APAARI representative Dr. Sahdev Singh attended the ICT Expert Consultation organized by GFAR and AARINENA in February 2003 at Cairo, Egypt and presented a brief overview of APAARI experience in developing its own information system, APARIS.
- APAARI representative Dr. A.K. Bawa participated in the Second International Workshop on Lentil Improvement in South Asia held from 24-28 February 2003 at Kathmandu, Nepal and presented APAARI suggestions to include lentil in CLAN activities.
- Several APAARI stakeholders participated in the GFAR meeting in Dakar, Senegal in May 2003, supported by GFAR and facilitated by APAARI Secretariat.
- APAARI representatives Mr. P.K. Saha and Dr. Sahdev Singh attended FAO organized Regional Consultation on Capacity Building in Biosafety of GM Crops in Asia held in Bangkok, Thailand from 7-10 July 2003.
- APAARI representative Dr. Sahdev Singh attended the CLAN Steering Committee Meeting held from 10-12 November 2003 at ICRISAT, Hyderabad, India. APAARI also supported delegates from Iran, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Thailand to attend this meeting.
- APAARI supported participation of delegates from India, Bangladesh, Thailand and Philippines in the GM seed detection training-cum-workshop organized jointly by FAO and ISTA at Bangkok from 25 to 29 November 2003.
- APAARI Executive Secretary participated in the GFAR Steering Committee meeting held recently at Nairobi, Kenya at the invitation of GFAR and made presentation on APAARI activities during the year 2002-2003.

Conclusion

Overall, APAARI's diverse activities have provided further thrust on strengthening partnership, collaboration and networking in agricultural research and development in the Asia-Pacific region, meeting the NARS emerging needs and expectations. APAARI looks forward to strengthen partnership with ARD organizations in pursuing common goals and objectives, especially in areas of genetic resource conservation and biotechnology, NRM related activities, ICT networking and commodity chain programs. APAARI also looks forward to strengthen inter-regional partnership with other Fora engaged in agricultural research and development through active support and involvement of GFAR. APAARI would like to move forward to have "Gap Analysis" based on regional/sub-regional priority setting exercises undertaken earlier and ensure collaborative efforts to bridge those gaps. Areas of biotechnology and post-harvest technology will be addressed on priority through new programs, such as APCoAB, and expert consultation on post-harvest technologies, which APAARI plans to organize along with next General Assembly to be held in December 2004.
