INET會議是ISOC (Internet Society) 所舉辦的國際網路年度會議，為世界最大的網路年會，歷年輪流在世界各國舉辦，今（2004）年在西班牙巴塞隆納舉辦13屆INET會議，並與IGC (Internet Global Congress) 合作共同辦理 **INET/IGC2004 in Barcelona**。

**INET/IGC2004**主題為：強化網路-建構一個開放與值得信任的網際網路。

本次主題除含括網路技術的探討外，更加強網路管理與全球合作的概念與討論，我國藉此機會參考及擷取他國的經驗，以健全我國網路的管理及未來的發展。

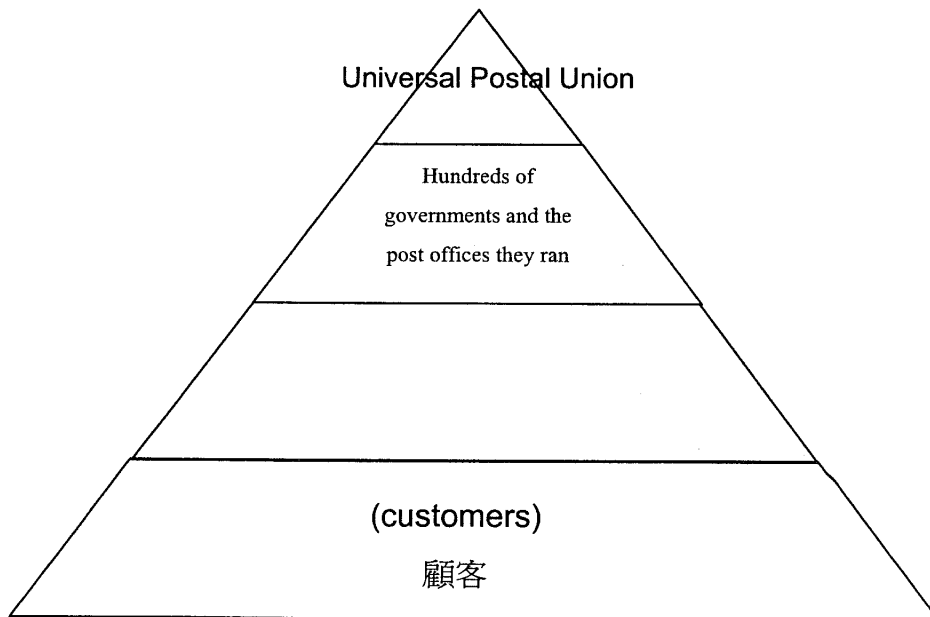

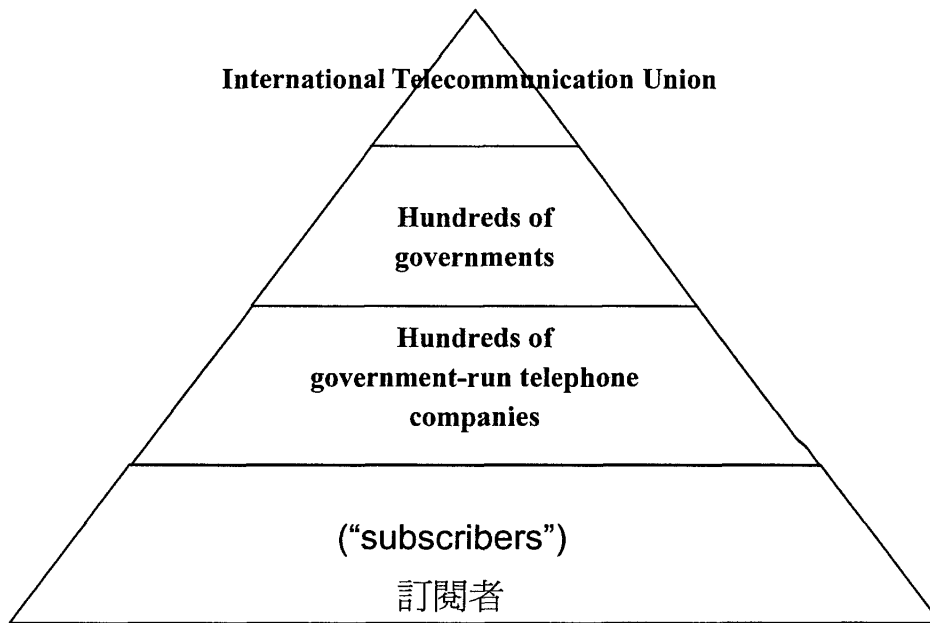
## 五、會議心得

(一) 所參加的" **Managing the Internet I, II, III, IV** "系列主題【相關議題整理於本報告之頁 2，四.- (二)】，分別從「西元 1950 年代 **Mail Governance about Postal Service** (郵件管理，如圖一)」、「西元 1970 年代 **Phone Governance about Phone Service** (電話系統管理，如圖二)」，一直討論到目前「針對網路而言，誰在做決定(Who makes choices about the Net?)」，討論中舉例：網路上所有的使用者？IT 代理商？ISPs？政府單位？網路組織？或是非政府組織 (NGO) 等等，並藉由 **Layers of the Information Society** (如圖三)，廣泛的從教育和訓練、軟體、電子商務、網路內容、電腦軟硬體、Internet (網際網路)、通訊網路一直到法律層面等不同面向來討論加強全球未來『網際網路的合作、發展與管理方式』。相關資料請至網站：<http://www.isoc.org/isoc/conferences/inet/04/presentations.shtml>，下載，"**Who Manages the Internet by Michael R. 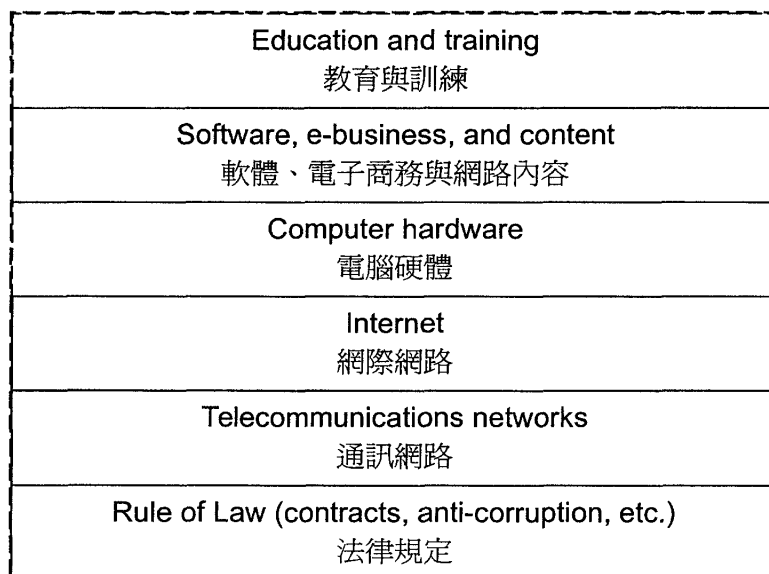


圖一. Mail Governance

(二) 針對網際網路的世界，討論到全球整合 (Global Coordination) 之必要性的問題，特別整理與會中所提到未來網際網路需要整合的議題如下所示：

1. 網路智慧財產權的保護
2. 網路安全的問題
3. 未來網際網路的協定或標準的訂定
4. 未來 IP 位址的分配問題
5. 如何提供網路建設較為落後國家之相關協助或是教育訓練等
6. 網路身分確認或數位簽章等問題
7. 網路買賣與交易的規則

(三) 目前整個歐洲對於重新思考 Internet Governance 議題，在此次的會議上舉凡來自產業界、政府單位、學術單位、研究單位及非政府組織 (NGO, Non-Governmental Organization) 等均相當的熱烈討論與關心此項議題，就下列所提

1. 傳統社會的架構
2. 未來虛擬社會的架構
3. 國際社會的合作架構

深入討論對於未來網路虛擬社會的統治或是管理方式，究竟是藉由「Internet Protocol (網際網路協定)」、「Standard (標準)」、「Politics (政治力)」、「Cooperation (合作)」、「法律 (Law)」、「Technology (技術)」或是「.COM」等不同的角度與面向，來重新思考將來跨國界的網際網路管理 (Internet Governance)，並進一步思索未來「世界網路組織」的組成與發展。

(四) 與會上對於歐洲不管在發展 Internet Technology 或是 E-Learning Content，根據與會上的觀察與詢問，歸納其核心的思考價值在於「使用者需要什麼？」、「使用者是否真的需要？」、「現有的資源可以提

供？」與「是否可以藉由技術的開發來推動相關需求或是內容的提供？」，以「人」為思考與推動技術發展的價值觀。比較容易產生「精緻」與滿足「人使用」的產品。

## 六、對未來國內網路發展之建議

(一) 針對 **Internet Governance** (網路管理) 或是未來可能成立的「世界網路組織」，建議臺灣的政府部門應邀請相關產業界、學術單位、研究單位及非政府組織 (NGO, Non-Governmental Organization) 等，可針對下列方向進行討論，共同討論臺灣在全球電腦硬體資訊大國原有的良好基礎下，及早思考如何參與「世界網路組織」，發揮在「網路地球村」的實質影響力。相關資料請至網站：

1. 針對跨國界的網際網路，需要管理的事、物是什麼？
2. 臺灣對於 **Internet Governance** (網路管理) 的認知是什麼？
3. 了解掌控網際網路運作或控制的因子是什麼？
4. 未來如可能成立「世界網路組織」，臺灣的政府部門、民間企業、學術單位、研發單位、非政府組織分別要扮演何種腳色？

(二) **INET/IGC2004 in Barcelona, Spain** 一個重要的議題是在於討論網際網路管理 (**Internet Governance**)，特別是提供給政府單位與政策決定者的參考，並且後續已在相關的國家展開不同的討論，部分共識是藉由合作模式 (**Cooperation Model**) 去維護一個「開放的 (Open)」、 「具共識的 (Consensual)」以及「包容的 (Inclusive)」網際網路 (**Internet**)，應該是可能成功的一個方式。

在此並整理 **INET/IGC2004 in Barcelona, Spain** 之後，其它國家對於此次類主題的延續討論：

- 1.針對「重新思考網際網際的管理」議題：討論促進開發中國家與公民社會組織參與全球網際網路的相關工作
- 2.針對「重新思考網際網際的管理」議題：討論政府與政府之間相關機構與 ICAAN 的關係
- 3.針對「重新思考網際網際的管理」議題：討論包括政府與政府之間相關機構、私人管理機構與公共組織等所應扮演的腳色
- 4.討論下一世代政策與下一世代網際網路的關係
- 5.重新檢討制定網際網路標準（Internet Standard）的規則
