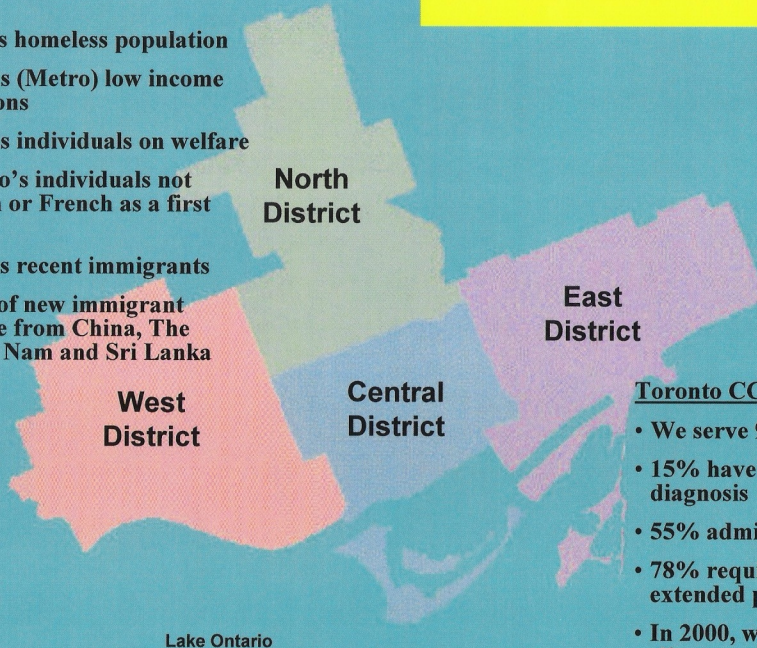


Our Diverse Communities

The Old City of Toronto's population has:

- TB rate 3.1x higher than Ont. avg.
- HIV/AIDs rate 11.3x higher than Ont. avg.
- 40% of Ontario's homeless population
- 34% of Toronto's (Metro) low income unattached persons
- 26% of Toronto's individuals on welfare
- 51.5% of Toronto's individuals not speaking English or French as a first language
- 56% of Toronto's recent immigrants

Highest number of new immigrant populations come from China, The Philippines, Viet Nam and Sri Lanka



Toronto CCAC's clients:

- We serve 9,400 clients a day
- 15% have primary mental health diagnosis
- 55% admitted are > 65 years old
- 78% require services for an extended period
- In 2000, we served 9,702 homeless clients and 587 clients in Out of the Cold Programs
- On avg. there are 1,100 children on our caseload
