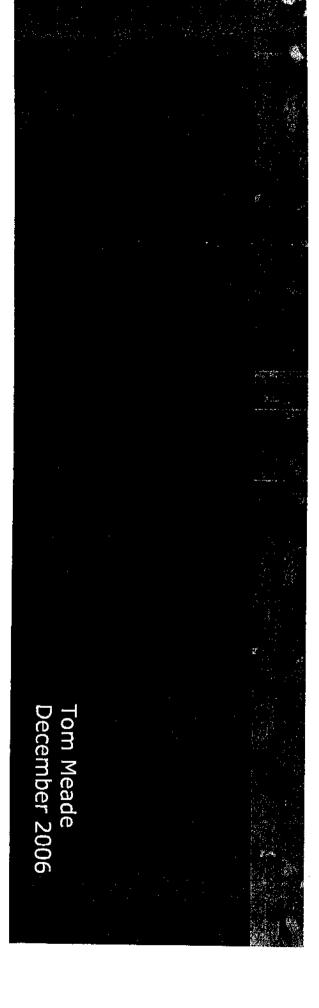

- Investment Service Providers Supervision

- Maintain integrity & stability of financial system
- Monitor Compliance with standards

- Authorisation process for funds
- Authorisation process for Promoters, Management Cos, and Investment Managers
- Minimum Activities in the State
- Authorisation of service providers
- Manager/Administrator, Trustee,

Ongoing supervision of service providers and funds

Minimum Activities in the State

The following activities must be conducted in the State by **Administrators:**

- Calculation of NAV and dealing price
- Accounting records and reconciliations
- Shareholder register
- Correspondence with unit holders
- Back-up documents
- Substantive administration and control

Who Is Supervised?

Supervision:

- Administrators/ Managers
- Trustees
- Management Companies
- Irish-Authorised Funds

Not Supervised:

Non-Irish Funds

Trustee - Role

- Independent role from Administrator
- Monitoring compliance with Prospectus/trust deed
- Monitoring investment breaches

NAV calculation / errors

- Site Visits
- Cannot delegate trustee role

Direct Supervision

- Desk Top
- Regulatory Reporting
- Reviews
- Day to day issues
- Issues Pricing/ NAV errors

Fraud

- On -Site
- Inspections
- Specific Issues Pooling, AML

Management Companies

Desk Top Supervision

- Assessment of Compliance with Capital Adequacy
- Ongoing changes to structure, director changes, ownership changes, business plans.

Inspection

- Assessment of compliance with business plan
- Review managerial functions
- Review of Board Minutes
- Discussion with directors/staff
