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壹、前言

世界知名的歐元集團 (Euromoney and Institutional Investor) 於今 (94) 年3月向本會表示,根據其會員反應,對本會成立以來,所採行的各項國際化與自由化金融改革措施予以高度肯定,為進一步瞭解我國投資環境,該機構決定以我國為主題,邀本會及我國知名上市公司參與於10月13、14日在美國紐約17、18日在英國倫敦舉行的「台灣全球投資論壇」,介紹我國產業發展現況。

此行之具體成果可以分述如下:

1. 積極推動國際交流,突破困境,爲台灣在國際發聲

由於本會成立以來積極參與國際金融活動,再加上龔主委遇去二十多年從事國際金融工作,此次爭取各方協助,得以順利安排在紐約證券交易所及倫敦證券交易所開盤敲鐘,並經由國際媒體報導,全球一億三千萬觀眾均可收看到本活動。

美國金融界多位重量級人士共同參與本項論壇相關活動,顯示對台灣此次國際活動的重視,包括:前任紐約聯邦準備銀行主席與前商業部長及全球知名私募基金美國黑石集團(The Blackstone Group)創辦人兼資深董事長Peter G. Peterson、前美國駐聯合國副常任代表費浩偉大使(Harvey Feldman)、英國貿工部貿易暨投資促進總署次長級執行長Sir Stephen Brown,及英國上院議員福克納勳爵(The Lord Faulkner of Worcester)分別在紐約及倫敦論壇擔任專題主講人。前美國證管會主席Bill Donaldson、前參議員Phil Gramm則應邀擔任本會駐紐約辦事處開幕儀式的致詞貴賓。其中參議員Phil Gramm曾任參議院銀行委員會主席多年,促成Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act之通過,該法案打破美國1933年以來Glass - Steagal Act的限制,准許美國銀行業得跨業經營。

本次活動期間適逢本會紐約辦事處成立,故一併於10月13日舉行開幕儀式,包括紐約證交所執行長John Thain、黑石集團執行長Tony James、紐約州銀行廳副廳長David Fredsall、紐約市政府退休基金財務長及各大金融機構高階主管等皆應邀參加,晚會出席之中外人士超過三百人。與會人士表示,本會紐約辦事處的成立不但可深化雙邊關係,對於跨國金融監理合作有其必要性,因此樂見本會設立駐紐約辦事處。

2. 向國際投資人說明政府金融改革的決心

外資對我國未動用政府資金購買不良資產,也未動用政府資金對銀行增資,能成功地



將本國銀行逾期放款比率,從11.76%降至2.87%,備抵呆帳覆蓋率提升至40%以上,淨 值報酬率提升至10%以上,而自有資本比率維持在10%以上,與日、韓等國不同,印 象甚爲深刻。

有關金融整併方面,本次台灣論壇正好向國際投資人直接澄清疑慮,説明政府對金融整併的決心。本會除說明近期所採取開放金融市場及健全資本市場的各項改革措施,並引述 總統在國慶日談話中重申金融改革的決心,獲國際投資人非常正面的回應。

3. 投資論壇舉辦時機恰當,展現台灣產業及政府的國際化及活力

本次投資論壇紐約及倫敦合計600餘位的國際重要金融機構的高階經理人及財金專業人士與會。據主辦單位統計,與會投資人所管理之資產總額高達5.82兆美元,所管理資產總額已逾全球總投資資產的七成。此外,本會及與會上市公司的一對一會談更高達三百六十九場。

依據與會的紐約市退休基金財務長表示,近期參加過印度、中國、韓國及印尼等多個國家的投資說明會,認爲我國本次與會之官員及業界代表素質水準高過前述國家,皆能以流利的英文清楚傳遞第一手資訊,並和國際投資人面對面交換意見,相當難得。也有多位與會重要國際機構投資人反映,希望本會定期舉辦類似投資論壇,以使投資人瞭解台灣產業、金融的發展,不是只瞭解台灣的半導體產業。

4. 加強與全球指數編製機構MSCI合作

龔主委率本會人員及證交所吳乃仁董事長、期交所何富雄總經理拜會全球知名之指數編製機構摩根資本國際公司 (MSCI) 總裁Henry A. Fernandez,雙方對促成期交所將與該公司洽談指數授權事宜獲得共識,有利期交所推出美元計價之摩台指數期貨與選擇權商品,以持續增加我國現貨市場未來成長動能。

MSCI總裁對我國資本市場近年來資本市場法規鬆鄉的努力十分稱許,他並表示,台灣 人民的企業家精神是日本、韓國所難以比擬;而香港受中國影響甚深,新加坡整體市 場則規模較小,故其認爲台灣有條件發展成爲亞太金融服務中心。

5. 台灣債券市場納入雷曼兄弟全球綜合指數

經拜訪國際知名投資銀行雷曼兄弟公司 (Lehman Brothers) 後,獲確認95年1月將台灣 債券市場將納入該公司全球綜合指數 (Global Aggregate Index),對引導國際投資機構



大幅進入我國債券市場,並進而擴大及活絡我國債券市場有極大幫助。

6. 美國花旗集團將組專案團隊協助我國債市發展

美國花旗集團全球資本市場執行長Thomas G. Maheras經此次本會拜訪後,對我國債券市場之發展現況表達高度興趣,同意組成專案團隊,協助我國債券市場發展。該集團總部已指派台灣區利明獻總裁儘速研提相關意見,將花旗集團之國際實務經驗提供予本會參考。

經由參與論壇、一對一會議及企業界意見交流得知,台灣在國際投資人的眼光中,產業、金融發展面非常穩定,惟對於兩岸議題、公司治理及股市的流動性較爲關切。

此行與國際機構投資人及重要金融機構負責人之會談中,彼等均強烈表達對本會參加本次「台灣全球投資論壇」之肯定,且建議應定期舉辦類似論壇,以使國際投資機構更加瞭解我國產業及金融之發展現況。





参、主委致詞

Message

It is my great pleasure to attend the 2005 Taiwan Global Investment Forum and meet all of you.

Taiwan has changed rapidly in recent years and we think it is the right time for us to meet with you. In the technology sector, Taiwan's technology industry has been transformed from a manufacturing hub to a research, design and specialist manufacturing base. In the financial sector, Taiwan's financial services industry has become the flagship of the service industry in Taiwan. The GDP generated from the financial service industry represented approximately 12% of Taiwan's total GDP in 2004. In the telecom sector, Taiwan's growth in the industry is also tremendous. Taiwan's mobile phone penetration rate reached over 100% at the end of 2004 and is ranked No. 1 in the world.

As part of the financial reform and to achieve the financial efficiency, the Financial Supervisory Commission was established on July 1, 2004 as a single financial regulator at the cabinet level to integrate the supervision of the banking, securities, futures and insurance industries. Similar to the US SEC, the ROC Legislative Yuan also empowered the FSC with the quasi-judicial power to enhance the law enforcement. Since its establishment over one year ago, the FSC has accomplished extensive financial reforms we have begun to realize some of the government's aims; regulatory cooperation has been greatly enhanced.

The FSC's ultimate goal is to create a fair, sound and competitive financial environment and to build Taiwan as a regional financial gateway. As part of the financial reforms, the FSC deregulated the over-regulated financial services and products, removed legal barriers for the industry's consolidation and adopted new rules and regulations in line with international practices. We believe that with a more internationalized policy to facilitate the development of the Taiwanese financial industry and the capital market, we will see more fruitful improvements and results in the near future.

I am very pleased to take this opportunity to meet all the distinguished participants, hope that the business delegates from Taiwan can utilize this platform to exchange opinions with global institutional investors. I wish the Taiwan Investment Forum a great success!



The Taiwan Global Investment Forum was held in association with the Financial Supervisory Commission and sponsored by the Taiwan Stock Exchange Corporation.
