#### **BACKGROUND**

- The 4<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit originally targeted AFTA to be realized by 2008
- The 6<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit decided to accelerated the timeframe to 2002
- ASEAN: "One vision, One identity,
   One Community"

#### **BACKGROUND**

- ISO/IEC/ITU message on the World Standards Day: "One Standard, One testing, One Certification, accepted every where"
- ASEAN's Strategy for reducing technical Barriers to trade for Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE)
- Total Intra-ASEAN trade in EEE ≈ 90 Bil (USD)
   (2006 2007)

#### **BACKGROUND**

- Total Extra-ASEAN trade in EEE ≈
   289 Bil (USD) (2006-2007)
- EEE regulated by 8 out of 10 ASEAN
   Members States

#### **ASEAN EE MRA**

- ASEAN EE MRA signed in April 2002
- Provisions under the EE MRA
  - Matrix of Information Exchange
  - Mutual acceptance of test reports by listed Testing Laboratories
  - Mutual acceptance of certification by listed
     Certification Bodies
- The objective of EE MRA is to reduce Technical Barriers to trade for regulated EEE


#### **ASEAN EE MRA**

- Status of EE MRA implementation
  - All 10 Member States participating in Acceptance of test reports
  - 7 Member States participating in Acceptance of Certification
- Listing CABs
  - Testing Labs 15 (S'pore.2, Thai.5, Mal.1, Indo.4, Viet.2, Phi.1)
  - Certification Bodies 2 (S'pore.1, Viet.1)
- Shortcoming of EE MRA
  - Different standards
  - Different conformity assessment procedures

## ASEAN HARMONIZED EEE REGULATORY REGIME (AHEEERR)

- AHEEERR signed in December 2005
- To be implemented by 31 December 2010
- The objective: to realise ASEAN common market for EEE




### IMPLEMENTATION OF EE MRA & AHEEERR

- Role of JSC EE MRA / JSC EEE
  - setup listing procedures
  - consider and decide on harmonised standards
  - consider and list CABs
  - support Member States
  - monitor the implementation

### IMPLEMENTATION OF EE MRA & AHEEERR

- Criteria for listing CABs
  - Testing lab accredited by National Accreditation body to ISO/IEC 17025 or IEC EE CB Scheme
  - Certification body accredited by National Accreditation body to ISO/IEC Guide 65
  - Accreditation by Signatories of APLAC/ILAC MRA and PAC/IAF MLA



# BENEFITS OF EE MRA & AHEEERR

- Benefits to suppliers
  - Lower compliance cost
  - Reduced time to market
  - Certainty to export EEE to the markets of MRA partners

# BENEFITS OF EE MRA & AHEEERR

- Benefits to consumers
  - Lower cost of EEE
  - Greater varieties of EEE
- Benefits to regulator
  - Reduced administrative cost
