100% EE Products imported.

Product Registration Requirements:-

- Standards alignment or harmonise to International Standards such as IEC Standards, etc.
- Conformity Assessment activities compulsory Test Report and Certification from Approved CABs

Obligations:-

- Review Regulatory Requirements and Administrative provisions to suit the ASEAN Harmonised EEE Regulatory Regime by 2011
- WTO-TBT Agreement.

"Obligations: adhere to APEC EE MRA and the WTO-TBT on free movements of goods and services".

Way Forward

- Harmonize Regulatory Requirements.
 - Alignment / Harmonization to International Standards such as IEC etc.
- Designating Authority to Register EEE Products (Manufactured locally) once the issuance of CoC by Designated Certification Bodies.
- NAB's participation in APLAC MRA or PAC MRA
- Testing Facilities a member of IEC EE CB Scheme or accredited to ISO/IEC 17025 : 2005.

Way Forward

- Certification Bodies a member of IEC EE FCS or accredited to ISO/IEC Guide 65.
- Taskforce Committee / Working Group to identify gaps and bridging Developing and Developed APEC Member Economies toward pursuing the APEC EE MRA.
