Principle of Regulatory Regime for EEE in Thailand

- *Industrial Product Standards Act. B.E.2511 (1968)*
together with its amendments
and relevant *Ministerial Regulations*
- **33 Mandatory Standards**
- *Thai Industrial Standards Institute (TISI)*

Industrial Product Standards Act B.E.2511

- **Promulgated in 1968**
- **Section 17 stated that**
 - “ For the purpose of ensuring safety or preventing harmful effect which may befall the public, the industry or economy of the country, any particular kind of industrial products which shall conform with a standard may be determined.”

Industrial Product Standards Act B.E.2511

- Section 20 and 21 stated that

“ person who manufacturers / import for sale the industrial products which are required by the *Royal Decree* to conform with the standard must produce an evidence to a competent official for inspection and receive a *license* from the *Council*.

The *application* for a license, the inspection and the issue of a license shall be in accordance with the rules and procedures prescribed in the *Ministerial Regulation*.”

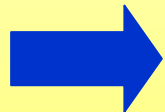
Conformity Assessment Procedure

[Type Testing + QMS Assessment + Surveillance]

Regulatory Authority

- **Thai Industrial Standards Institute (TISI),
Ministry of Industry**
- **Established by the Industrial Product Standards Act.
since 1968**
