INFRINGEMENT NOTICE

You have been, or are about to be, issued with an Infringement Notice pursuant to section 154(s) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 in respect of making an erroneous declaration (unintentional, accidental, by mistake, without knowledge, carelessness or forgetfulness).

This offence is one of *Strict Liability*. Discussions for alternative treatments will not be entered into. Infringements will be issued in all cases.

This particular offence is designed specifically to address erroneous declarations. This is why the fine is set for NZ\$200.

When people undertake the same act intentionally they may face a fine of up to NZ\$100,000 and/or 5 years imprisonment.

Risk goods that are brought into New Zealand have the potential to seriously harm New Zealand's environment and primary production industries. The risk is the same even if the person carrying the risk goods does not do so deliberately.

This infringement notice was introduced to New Zealand due to the very high percentage of persons arriving found to be making a false declaration through carelessness or forgetfulness.

You do not receive a criminal history, nor will any other agency/department have knowledge of this offence.

FINE INFRINGEMENT NOTICE

OPTIONS

AUTHORITY FOR NOTICE.

Under section 154(s) Biosecurity Act 1993 an infringement notice can be issued to any person who erroneously (unintentional, accidental, by mistake, without knowledge, careless or forgetfulness) declares that he or she is not in possession of any good specified on the declaration card.

YOUR CHOICE

Should you be issued with an Infringement Notice you may choose to:

PAY THE PENALTY OF \$200 NOW

(NZ\$ cash, major credit cards, NZ eft-pos accepted)

OR

PAY THE PENALTY OF \$200 at the address specified on the Infringement Notice within **14 days** after service of this notice.

OR

YOU MAY DISPUTE THE NOTICE AND REQUEST A HEARING IN COURT*

By writing to the address specified on the Infringement Notice **within 14 days** after issue of this notice.

The only correspondence that will be entered into is a request, in writing, for a hearing in court.

No other correspondence will be entered into regarding this matter.

OR

YOU MAY DO NOTHING* The Infringement Notice will be filed at the District Court and demand for payment will be made by the Department of Courts.

* If you choose to do nothing or to dispute the matter, you may be liable for associated Court Costs.

* If you do not dispute the Infringement Notice within 14 days you will not automatically be entitled to a hearing.

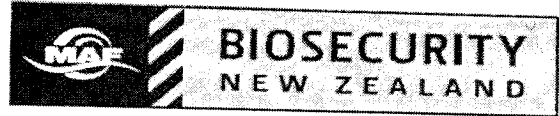

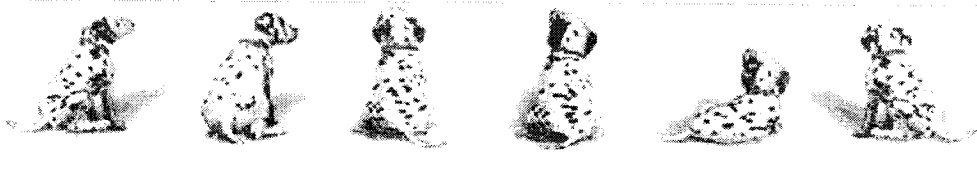

General Information

Dog Accommodation

Pethaven Quarantine has 17 units in its facility. The single units sizes are as follows: Single kennel sleeping area 1.5m x 2.4m outside exercise area is 1.5m x 4.1m: Large units have 2 kennel sleeping area's 1.5m x 2.4m and the exercise area is 4.1m x 3.1m.

Extra large unit (one only) 3 sleeping area's and the exercise area is 4.6m x 4m

The outside exercise runs are half roofed so that all pets get shade and sun, as they require. Our facility is unique in the way that not only can they look out over expansive farmland but they have visual contact with their neighbours. All indoor kennels are carpeted for your pet's comfort and warmth.

All units have heating when required.

Cat Accommodation

We have 10 cat units available. Six large units (1400cm x 1400cm x 2400cm) and 4 extra large units (2300cm x 1900cm x 2400cm). The interior is fully insulated and heating is provided in all units. Our facility is separate from the main kennels and dog quarantine area so as not to frighten any nervous residents.

Diet

We feed all our quarantine dogs and cats on Royal Canin a Premium Dry food. If your pet requires a special diet, please advise us as we are happy to accommodate (Special diets are the responsibility of the owner to provide and these must come in a vermin proof container)

We also add a variety of Pedigree Pal tinned food if required to stimulate appetite.

Dental chews are offered to all pets to help with tartar control and nice fresh breath.

Chew ropes and other toys are welcome (We request no tennis balls/sheepskins/bean bags)

Visiting Hours

We encourage owners to visit their pets while in quarantine. All owner/visitors are required by MAF to sign a visitor's logbook recording their details when entering and upon exiting of the quarantine facility. This book is held in the Office. MAF regulations require a number of restrictions that must be observed. These will be explained to you on your arrival at the facility.

All dogs imported into New Zealand must either have a blood test for *Leptospira canicola* or a course of antibiotics within 30 days of shipment. MAF Import Health Standard, Veterinary Certificate A 8.2
If your dog has been vaccinated against Leptospirosis, the blood test may show a positive Result and a course of antibiotics must be administered.

Please discuss with your Veterinarian or MAF New Zealand, which will be the best course of action to take in your circumstances.

If the owners are not aware of the situation and the dog tests positive then you may not have enough time prior to shipment for the course of antibiotics.

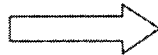

Summary of Quarantine Facility Rules

The following is a list of rules that owners and visitors are expected to comply with while on the quarantine station grounds. Management will notify owners and visitors when they observe violation of quarantine rules. Each owner and visitor shall abide by all facility rules and policies.

1. Any person who fails to present acceptable picture identification upon request may be denied admission.
2. You will be directed to your pets unit, please ensure you stay within the unit's area to avoid disturbing other pets.
3. For the health and safety of all persons and animals, all kennel doors must be properly latched from the inside to prevent any escapes or injuries.
4. Please do not feed, handle or visit other pets unless you have received written permission from the owner and this authorization is recorded at the office on our visiting procedures form.
5. Walking or removing dogs from their units is prohibited.
6. Please refrain children from running, behaving boisterously or putting fingers through the wire mesh of kennels.
7. The quarantine facility is a restricted area; please wear appropriate clothing and footwear while on the station grounds.
8. All visitors and tradesmen are required to use the foot-bath upon arrival and exit
9. No other animals are allowed on the quarantine station premises.
10. All visitors will be escorted off the premises after their visit.
11. Visiting hours are to be strictly adhered to. There will be NO access to pets outside visiting hours.

The contents of these instructions relate to dogs and cats. All information/documentation submitted to our office is held in the strictest confidence.

Importing your Pet/s Step by Step Guide

This step by step introduction is to help you understand your pets import process and should be used as a guideline only. This guide **does not supersede MAF Regulations**. We recommend all clients contact a reputable International Pet Transporter who will be able to assist with your pet/s import process. (Please ask Pethaven Quarantine for a current list of possible Pet Transporters in your local area/ Region/Country).

Step one: Microchip your pet

1. Microchip your pet/s with a microchip transponder clearly identifying the animal/s/ number and the date of implant.
(Important: Microchip number MUST be noted on all blood results, current rabies vaccination certificates and current vaccination certificates. Pet/s will require a rabies booster vaccination if the microchip was implanted AFTER the date of the most recent vaccination).

MICROCHIP MUST BE IMPLANTED AT LEAST 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO SHIPMENT AND BEFORE THE MOST RECENT RABIES VACCINATION.

Step two: First Rabies Titre Blood Collection.

2. Pet/s will need to be vaccinated against rabies with an approved inactivated virus vaccine. **At least 3 weeks** later, blood is drawn for the initial neutralising antibody titration test by your veterinarian. A letter is required from your veterinarian concerning the initial rabies titre blood collection date and confirmation/scanning of the microchip number of your pet/s. The timing of blood sampling shall be no less than 6 months, and no greater than 12 months from the scheduled date of departure. (e.g: If your pet/s blood collection date was the 1-1-07 then he/she would be eligible for export on or after the 1-7-07, but no later than 31-12-07)

The blood sample for Rabies testing MUST be tested at a laboratory approved by the Government Veterinary authorities of the exporting Country. The form must indicate that

the pet/s were subject to either the FAVN or RFFIT neutralising antibody titration test for rabies and demonstrates that at least 0.5IU/ml of antibody was present in the sample.

- Dog/s and cat/s must be **over 3 months** of age at the time of first rabies vaccination.
- Pets must have been resident in the exporting country for the 6 months prior to export and not have been resident in official quarantine premises in the 60 days immediately prior to export.
- Pet/s must not be more than 42 days pregnant at the time of shipment
- Pet/s must be more than 9 months old at departure.

Step three: Booking Your Quarantine space

3. Contact Pethaven Quarantine facility requesting our Quarantine Information Pack. Upon receiving the pack and Pethaven has confirmed quarantine space is available, submit your Booking Form with ALL appropriate owners details, pet details, vaccination details to Pethaven. Once we have this **BOOKING FORM** this becomes your “Letter” confirming availability of space for your pet/s at the time of importation and will be signed by Pethaven Quarantine and MAF. (A copy of this “Letter” plus the “**Import Confirmation letter**” will be sent to you or your agent/pet transporter). A copy of these forms will be required by Animal Imports Group to obtain an Import Permit.

Step four: Permit to Import

4. A permit to Import **must** be obtained before importation. Please attach the following information.
 - Import Permit Application form with all details completed on the form.
 - A letter from your veterinarian stating the date blood was collected from your pet/s. Please ensure the following details are also included on the veterinarians “Letter” **Name of pet, breed, colour, sex, DOB, Microchip number, date of implant**, and that this form is stamped, dated and signed by the veterinarian.
 - Rabies serum neutralising antibody test report (the form is to indicate that the animal to be imported was subjected to either the FAVN or RFFIT neutralising antibody titration test for rabies and demonstrates that at least 0.5IU/ml of antibody was present in the sample.
 - Booking Confirmation “letter” plus Import Confirmation letter signed by Pethaven Quarantine Ltd confirming availability of space for the pet/s at the time of Importation.

Applications should be made to: Animal Imports, Pre Clearance Directorate, Biosecurity New Zealand, Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MAF), P O Box 2526, Wellington, New Zealand.

Step five: Final 30 day tests(Dogs and Cats)

5. Within 30 days of scheduled pet/s departure date complete tests and treatments in Veterinary Certificate A. Please give a copy of the **New Zealand MAF Veterinary Certificate A** (Import Health Standards) to your veterinarian.

This will assist your vet concerning the various test methods and specific treatments that your pet/s must receive to comply with the New Zealand requirements.

Including a second neutralising antibody titration test for rabies.

Important information for your veterinarian.

In addition to the tests and treatments, each veterinary visit must include:

- Complete exam
- Scanning of the microchip to verify that the number is correct and that the microchip is functioning and has not migrated.
- Check for ectoparasites (fleas, ticks, ear mites, etc)
- Examine ears and clean if necessary.

Please note: Accredited Veterinarian A veterinarian accredited to provide **export certification** on behalf of the Government Veterinary Service. Please verify that your veterinarian is accredited to perform the Pre-entry procedures.

Step six: Dogs only

6. Within 30 days of export, blood tests for the following;

- Microfilariae concentration test (Knotts test)
- *Dirofilaria immitis* antigen test

(NB: The antigen test must be conducted at a Government approved laboratory and the microfilariae concentration test may be performed by a veterinary practitioner).

- *Brucella Canis* Agg
- *Leptospira Canicola* Agg-Lys
- (NB: If your dog/s have been vaccinated against Leptospirosis you may elect not to do the Leptospirosis blood tests. New Zealand MAF will accept a doxycycline treatment within 30 days of export as an alternative. This treatment must be at a therapeutic dose rate for 14 consecutive days. Doxycycline is an oral antibiotic treatment.
- *Ehrlichia Canis* IFA
- *Babesia gibsoni* IFA
- *Babesia gibsoni* (blood smear examination)

(Within 10 days of export date two blood tests for *Babesia Gibsoni* from samples collected at the same time, as follows)

- a) Indirect florescent antibody test for Babesia Gibsoni using antigens appropriate for the strain likely to be present in all countries where the dog has been resident, with a negative result (cut off 1:40)
- b) A thin Blood Smear made from a drop of blood from an ear margin, examined with a negative result for babesia gibsoni (Lab requires 2-3 slides).

Step seven: Dogs and Cats

7. Within 30 days of export; two negative hookworm faecal tests at least 14 days apart. Faecal tests maybe done IN-HOUSE by your vet using the sensitive floatation procedure.

Step eight: Dogs and Cats

8. Within 21 days of export: Praziquantel and Pyrantel Pamoate Treatments. A common drug that is used for the internal parasite treatment is Drontal (or Droncit with Strongid). Please instruct your vet to record the exact date of treatment and milligrams used.

Within 4 days of export treatment are as follows:

- Dog/s and cat/s: Exam, check for ectoparasites and scan/verify microchip.
- Dog/s only: Ivermectin or Milbemycin (as appropriate to the breed) –oral treatment
- Dog/s and cat/s: Praziquantel and Pyrantel Pamoate (using Drontal or Droncit with Strongid)
- Dog/s and cat/s: Topical flea and tick treatment-Frontline.
- Health Certificate.

Please ensure you have read the Information Pack thoroughly and understand the procedures that we have outlined in the pack. All test results are to be in **ENGLISH** and each test result must have the **MICROCHIP NUMBER** to identify the animal tested.

It is important we receive ALL the blood test results and faecal results for your pet/s. No pet/s will be for released until MAF has all these test results. Delays will occur if we have to collect blood for any missing blood test/s and the owner/agent is responsible for all costs incurred.

Please ensure ALL your documents, forms are signed and stamped by the Official Veterinarian, or a Veterinarian accredited to provide export certification on behalf of the Government Veterinary Service.
