

 - The deadline for the HoD recipient list of recommendations July 31, 2009
 - The Evaluation Committee members will evaluate and select 12 contestants (3 projects each for the first 4 categories) and one contestant for the special honorary (if any) as the semifinalists by October 15, 2009.

Article/Document Statistics (by subject)



Article/Document Statistics (by year)


☐ Amount of uploaded data on AFACT website by year (2001~2009/Oct 31)

Website Utilization (1/3)




Numbers of Viewers in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009/Oct 31

☐ The most popular 3 web surfing subjects are "News", "Events", and file download.


