報告內容摘要(請以 200 字~300 字說明)

Huong Le Thu, PhD student from IDAS, NCCU attend to the Harvard Conference 2010, Harvard Project on Asian and International Relations (HPAIR), „Asia Ascendant, Seizing New Heights”. The process of recruitment and selection was severe and Huong Le Thu was happy to successfully compete with young researchers from all over the world and be accepted to the Harvard Conference, in February 18-22 2010 in Cambridge, Boston.

The conference had 2 plenary session, one workshop and 6 panels, where delegates were assigned to and have to do preparation in advance. Thanks to her personal experiences, Huong Le Thu was invited by the HPAIR committee to act as a group leader for the case study “ASEAN future development” in the Regionalism Panel. Participation in the conference was very insightful, with many excellent speakers and eager young researchers from top worldwide universities. Huong LE Thu and her classmate Janet Tan, were the only two to represent Taiwan university, NCCU and promoted for IDAS program. They also actively negotiated with HPAIR director to consider sister partnership with NCCU Asia-Pacific Studies Association for the future exchanges, as well as inviting them to attend up-coming IDAS conference in June 2010.

政大亞太研究博士班二年級生-黎秋 於民國 99 年 2 月 18 到 22 日參加了哈佛大學亞洲國際學程舉辦的年會，主題為‘亞洲的優勢’。參與學者必須經過熱烈的篩選過程，我很榮幸能被選上代表台灣出席。

會程有兩個共同議題，一個工作坊，以及六個主題，每一個參加學人會被分配到他/她的專長主題研究。我參與的主題為區域研究，我的專題研究為‘東協的未來發展’。參加大會的學者皆非常專業，也多是從各方知名大學選出的，大會的邀請專家學者們皆世界一流。台灣參與此會只有 談仲光 與我兩位，而且皆是政大亞太研究博士班生，我們備感光榮。我們希望與哈佛學程建立姊妹關係，維持將來學習與互動，我們並希望能邀請他們參加亞太六月舉辦的國際會議。

The HPAIR annual conferences have been held since 1991 and bring together students from renowned universities around the world on the one hand, and leaders in academia, government, business as well as the arts on the other. HPAIR is a student-run organization of the Harvard University Faculty of Arts and Sciences, and the 5-day event in Harvard is a cooperative partnership between students and faculty. The conference is actually constructed to also act as an academic program. It consists of six workshops that actively engage students and bring them together with distinguished speakers to explore issues ranging from international security and economics to culture and environment. The topic of the 2010 Conference was "Asia Ascendant – Reaching New Heights" and the six panels included topics such as Asian leadership, global environment, regionalism in Asia, Asian perspective on economic crisis, Asia-Pacific security, and education issues in Asia. Huong participated in different panel discussions – regionalism in Asia. Under her panel, Huong also had the privilege to act as the group leader and moderate the discussion in the ASEAN study group, where she focused on community-building in the region since the ASEAN Charter came into effect. Delegates prepare beforehand to the discussion and to play their interest groups very well. The debates were heated and we learned a lot from the "mocked ASEAN meeting" process. Most insightful experience for me was to be able to listen and interact with distinguished scholars as guest speakers, including: Jorge I. Dominguez, Dale W. Jorgenson and Richard N. Cooper from Harvard University, and the participation in Negotiation skills workshop led by a member of Harvard Law School, the member of Harvard Negotiation Training Corps.

HPAIR was also a very good opportunity for us to practice social networking, we had delegates party, reception and the Gala dinner at Ritz Carton to socialize with each other as well as invited speakers. I made connection with the HPAIR organizer and expressed the will to help with organization future Harvard Conference, if consider to take place in Taiwan. The first Asian Conference of HPAIR actually took place in Taiwan in 1991, so it would be a good come-back after 20 years and serve a excellent promotion of Taiwan. We expressed the will to establish sister-relations between HPAIR and Asia-Pacific Studies Association, based in IDAS program, and invited Harvard students to participate in our up-coming IDAS International Conference in June 2010.
