摘要

本次 AFACT 會議是組織變革的首次召開，會議主要是針對組織更動與調整，作章程條文的適當修訂，並制定新委員會與工作組的職掌範圍與工作計畫等事宜，及討論本組織與國際組織間之資訊分享與交流方式。AFACT 改組後成立的三個執行委員會是「商業領域委員會(Business Domain Committee)」、「社群支援委員會(Community Support Committee)」及「技術方法委員會(Technology and Methodology Committee)」，並在商業領域委員會下附屬有「旅遊觀光休閒工作組(Travel Tourism and Leisure Working Group)」、「電子產證工作組(electric Certificate Of Origin Working Group)」。

在 2011 年的 AFACT 年會中將計畫成立「金融工作組」、「運輸工作組」等小組，各會員國可再提意向書成立其他新的工作組，惟需要至少三個會員體來參與組成，並制定 ToR 及 WoP 計畫書等文件送秘書處於 AFACT 會議討論及大會確認核准。2011 年的 AFACT 年會將在臺灣舉行。

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壹、前言

第 28 屆 AFACT 理事會(28th AFACT Steering Committee Meeting)、大會(Plenary)及委員會會議(Committee Meeting)，由主辦國日本 Japan Association for Simplification of International Trade Procedure (JASTPRO)主辦，於 2010 年 11 月 24 至 26 日假日本橫濱的 Mierparque Hotel 舉行，共為期 3 天。第一天由本屆主席(Japan) Mr. k. Hirai 召開理事會 (Steering Committee) 討論相關會議籌備事宜及工作方向。第二天針對各委員會議進行討論，共分成商業領域委員會 (BDC)、社團支援委員會(CSC)、技術方法委員會 (TMC)，及其附屬委員會之各工作小組等。第三天則是大會開幕式，除了各國代表團團長報告外，各委員會主席亦針對前一天會議所達成之結論向大會提出扼要說明，並提請大會確認相關事項。

本會議主要是以 AFACT 理事會成員為主，目前有 19 個會員國包括澳大利亞、韓國、泰國、巴基斯坦、中華台北、日本、伊朗、斯里蘭卡、印度、印度尼西亞、中華人民共和國、蒙古、馬來西亞、菲律賓、新加坡、越南、柬埔寨、阿富汗及沙烏地阿拉伯等，另外 Pan Asian E-Commerce Alliance(PAA)是 Associate member。本次會議共約有 45 位各國代表參加。

本次會議我國代表團成員共有十二位，分別來自經濟部標準檢驗局、財政部關稅總局、中華電信公司、資訊工業策進會等單位，並由資訊工業策進會資深專家柯志昇先生(Senior Fellow and Board Director)擔任代表團團長，團員則分別參加商業領域委員會 (BDC)、社團支援委員會(CSC)、技術方法委員會 (TMC)，及旅遊觀光休閒小組(TT&L WG)、電子產證小組(eCOO WG)等會議。(參與成員名單，如附件一)

參、會議重點與摘要

AFACT (Asia Pacific Council for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business) 會議是為推動與宣導亞太地區電子商務，及資料交換標準制定的應用，並促使亞太地區貿易流程簡化，進而達到貿易便捷化之目標。我國 TEC (Taipei EC/EDI Committee) 委員會於 2001-2009 年為 AFACT 常設秘書處，目前也擔任 AFACT 理事會副主席、TFT (Task Force Team) 召集人及 CSC (Community Support Committee) 委員會主席等職務，長年致力於電子商務、資料交換及產業電子化標準之推動。本次會議有助於瞭解 AFACT 組織之更動改組及亞太地區推展標準相關之策略方向，並藉由會議之交流提升與會各國間之互動與合作，增加與各國之實質關係，進而推展我國參與聯合國相關國際組織會議活動之空間。

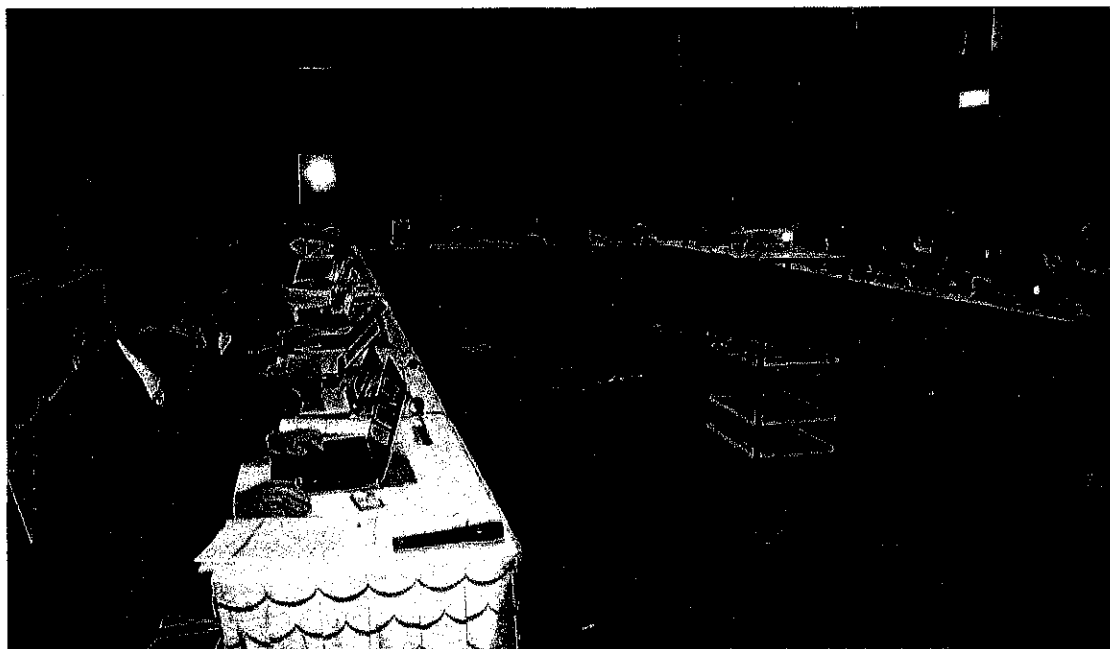

肆、心得與建議

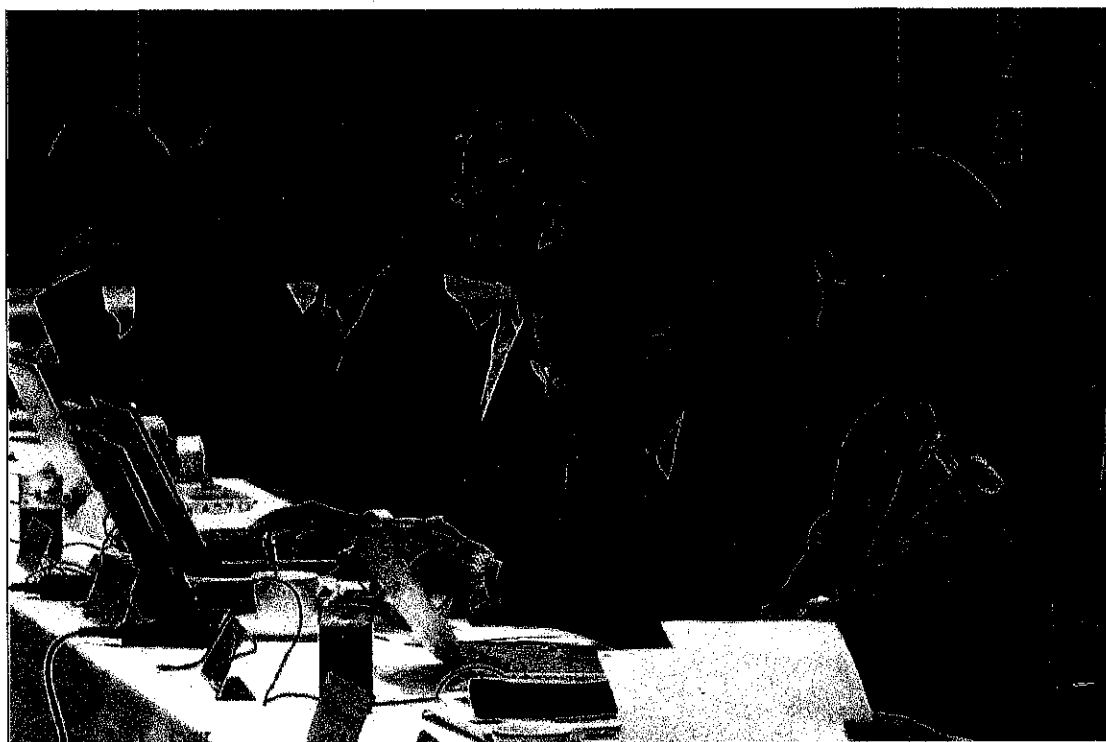
- 一. 本次會議因原主辦國（沙烏地阿拉伯）臨時無法舉辦，乃於 2010 年 3 月 29 日經電話會議改由日本接手 2010 年 AFACT 會議。日本事先在無編列預算下，各項會議場地時間的安排相當緊湊，會議各項議題主辦單位儘可能進行討論，但受限於時間及預算因素，本次會議並無舉行 EDICOM 研討會應是遺憾。
- 二. 本次 AFACT 年會主要討論 AFACT 組織變更及章程條文修改等議題。改組後分別成立 3 個委員會，即商業領域委員會(BDC)、社團支援委員會(CSC)、及技術方法委員會(TMC)，在 BDC 委員會下有成立 eCOO 工作組及 TT&L 工作組。各會員體可依其需要參與相關委員會或工作組，或提議成立新工作組。本次會議我國代表團分別參與委員會及相關工作組。
- 三. 本次為 AFACT 組織更動後的首次會議，藉由會議之交流可提升我國與各國間之互動與合作，並瞭解改組後各會員體參與情形，及委員會、工作組之活動動態。另我國雄獅旅遊公司參與新成立的 TT&L 工作小組，與會員體間交換旅遊休閒產業資訊，並將各會員體的旅遊資訊分享國內，也可提高我國與旅遊產業在國際的能見度，並帶動我國觀光產業。
- 四. 我國 TEC(Taipei EC/EDI Committee)委員會曾是 AFACT 常設秘書處(2001-2009 年)，長年致力於電子商務、資料交換及產業電子化標準之推動。目前 AFACT 的 TFT (Task Force Team) 召集人及 CSC 委員會(Community Support Committee)主席為我國擔任，對於 AFACT 之努力及貢獻深獲大會肯定。由於 2011 年臺灣將主辦 AFACT 會議，也欣逢我國建國一百週年，政府此時也將舉辦各種活動及慶祝會，建議值此建國百年紀念，把我國正在執行的重大計畫規劃情形與經驗介紹給 AFACT 與會者。該次會議將舉辦 EDICOM 研討會及 eASIA Award 競賽，研討會中將提供各會員體分享技術與開發經驗，eASIA 競賽也有機會展現各國的電子商務與資訊科技運用的各項成就。

五. 目前，我國正進行單一窗口及預先電子申報等重大計畫之規劃、建置，需要導入相關技術工具，並引用適合的國際標準，因我國非為聯合國會員，無法直接參與國際相關標準制定之過程，亦難以即時取得國際標準資料。建議應更積極參與各類國際性組織之活動，從區域性國際會議中促進與各國之實質合作關係，擴展我國參與聯合國全球經貿相關國際組織活動之機會，以利與國際接軌，提高我國的經貿競爭力。

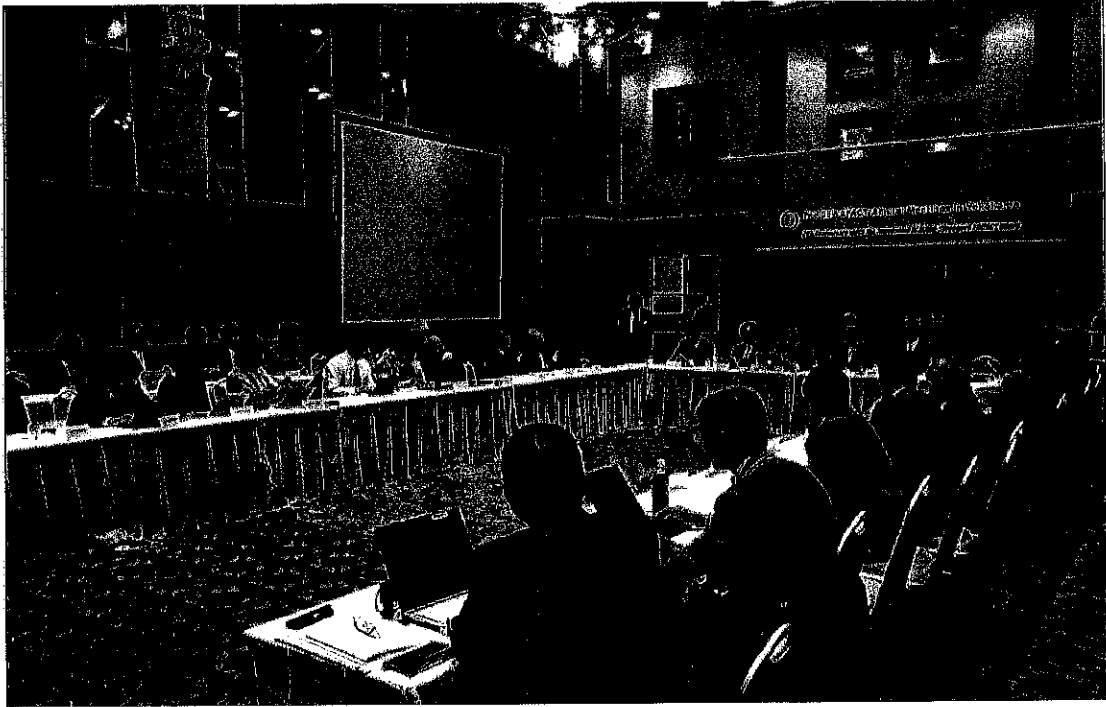

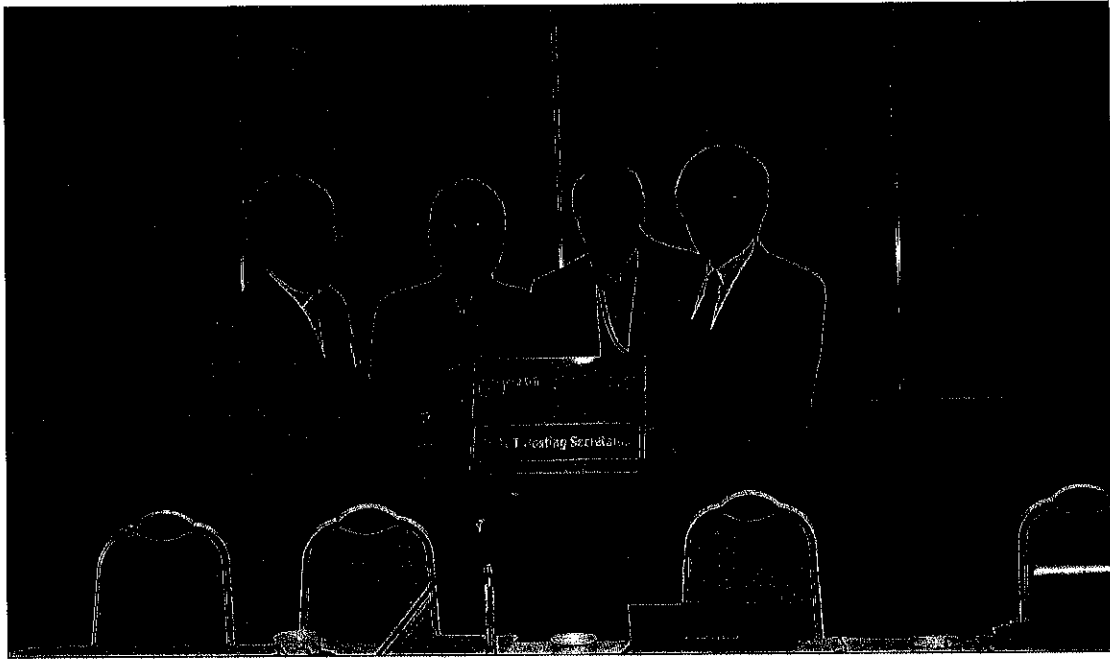

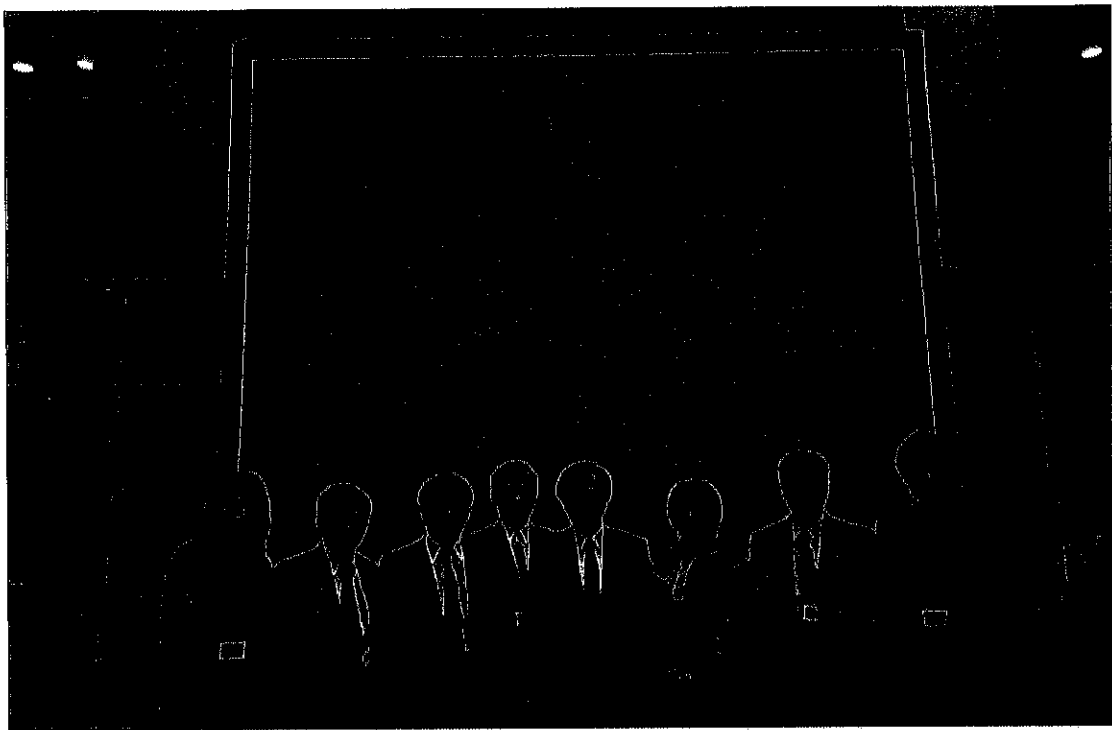

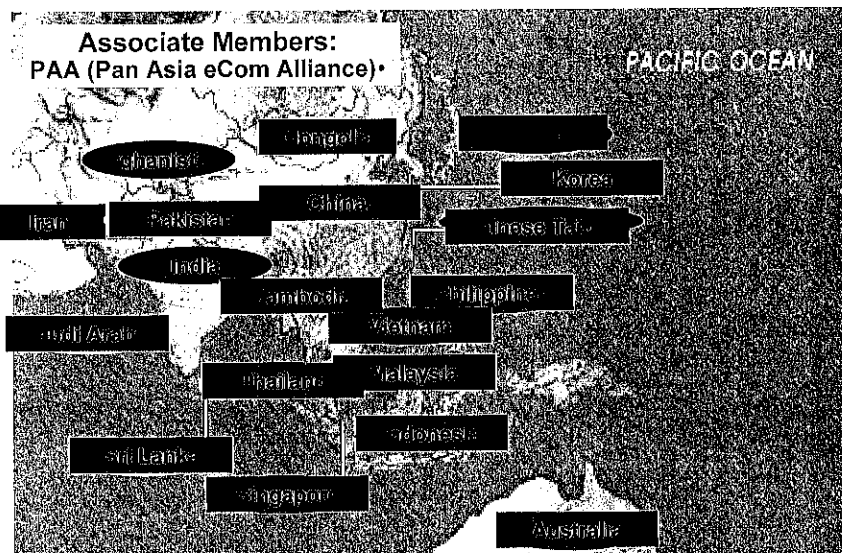

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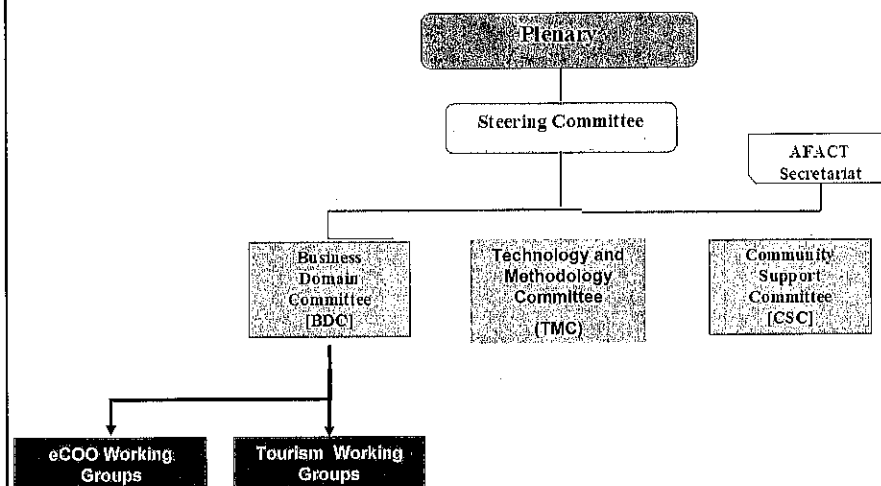

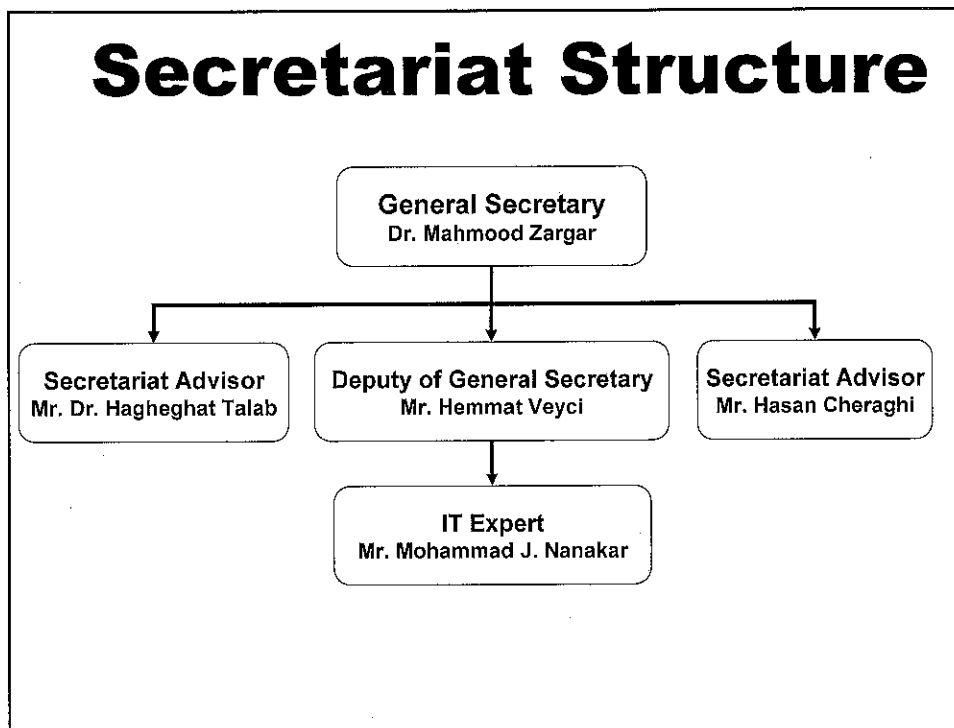

- Copy or certificate of registration.
According to resolution 1996/31 an organization "should attest that it has been in existence for at least two years as at the date of receipt of the application by the Secretariat". Please provide a copy of the registration paper or, if your country does not require registration, please provide other proof of existence.
- **Copy of most recent financial statement and annual report.**
- Copy of examples of your publications and recent articles or statements
- Optional: Organization chart (if available)

Completed applications must be received by the first day of June of the year before the year the NGO wants to be considered for recommendation by the Committee. For example, complete applications (which include a completed questionnaire and all the required supporting documentation) received by the NGO Branch before 1st June 2009, will be taken up by the Committee on NGOs in the year 2010. Applications received between the 1st June 2009 and 1st June 2010 will be taken up in the year 2011.

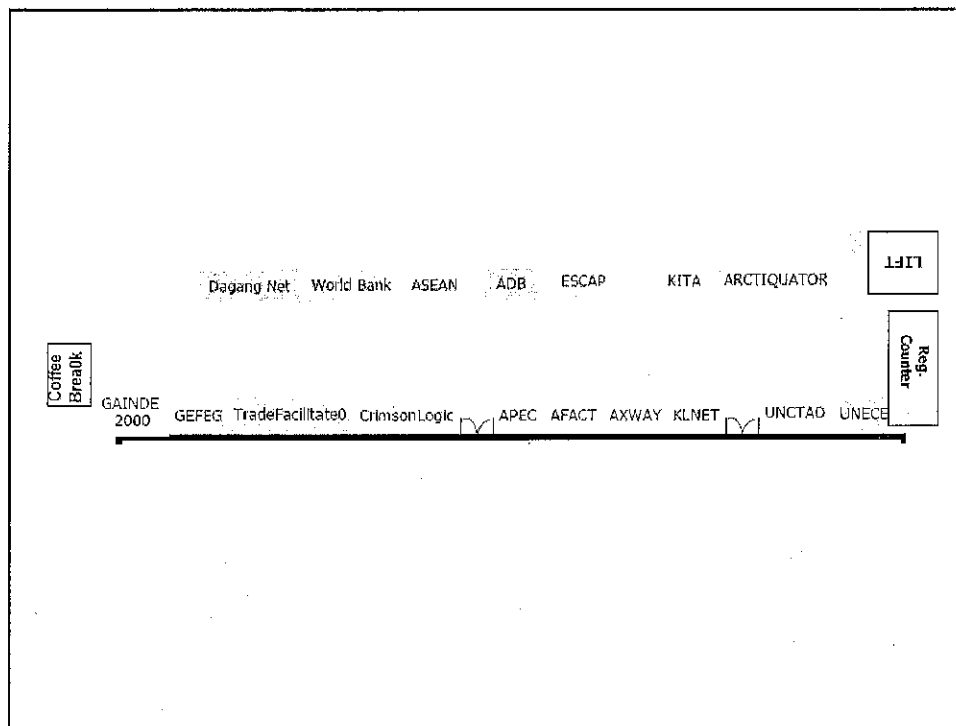




