壹、目的

國際政府資訊科技理事會(International Council for Information Technology in Government Administration, ICA)係由各國中央政府機關所成立,與電子化政府等資訊科技應用有關之國際專業組織。行政院研究發展考核委員會(以下稱本會)代表我國加入該組織,並於2008年於韓國首爾召開之第42屆年會上獲通過由我國辦理2011年年會,以及加入計畫委員會。

為履行會員國及計畫委員會成員之義務,爰由我國國家代表及國家副代表出席計畫委員會 2011 年第 1 次會議,報告 2011 年我國主辦 ICA 第 45 屆年會籌備情形,並且討論年會之各項演講題目及初步確認講者。

貳、過程

本次計畫委員會 2011 年第 1 次會議,於奧地利維也納召開,係由我國國家代表(本會資訊管理處簡副處長宏偉)、國家副代表(本會資訊管理處王科長誠明)出席,會議期程自 100 年 1 月 27日起至 1 月 28 日止,出席人員包括 ICA 主席 Peter Bruce(加拿大)、前任主席 Frank Leyman(比利時)、副主席 Mui Ken Chung(新加坡)、副主席 Shimon Broner(以色列)、財務長 Larry Caffrey(英國)、計畫委員會 Pierre Boucher(加拿大)、Darlene Meskell(美國)及我國代表等共 9 人,議程如附錄 1:

参、各項討論重點

一、2011年第45屆年會我國籌備進度報告,委員意見

ICA 財務長 Larry Caffrey 談到近年來舉辦 ICA 大會時,常有國家出席人員未全程參與會議,希望大家可以集思廣益,研擬改善的方法。

Larry 也談到 ICA 第 45 屆年會適逢我國 100 年國慶,屆時機票恐怕一位難求,建議請各會員國及早確定出席人選並訂妥機票。此外,經本會詢問後,Larry 也提到可以依歷年既有模式,支應臺灣辦理 ICA 年會部分經費。

二、第45屆會議主題及議程

2011 年會主題暫定為「Innovative Government – Learning From the Past, Looking to the Future」,時間訂在 10 月 11 日至 14 日 (10 月 11 日為委員會議)。由於本會議在我國召開,因此包括開幕致歡迎詞、開幕主題演講、以及多項會議演講等,均由我國邀請相關貴賓及講者,目前本會已在邀請中。

三、後續進行之作業

為確保 ICA 第 45 屆年會順利辦理,本會已成立 ICA 45 籌備小組, 由本會宋副主任委員餘俠擔任召集人、資管處何處長全德擔任執 行秘書。本籌備小組將確認 ICA 第 45 屆年會籌備事宜及各項工 作進程,並且提供相關建議以促使本計畫順利且完善執行。本籌 備小組另將於 ICA 年會期間,依相關分工協助議事順利進行, 並且主動積極提供與會貴賓各項服務與幫助。

有關ICA 財務長 Larry 擔心今年10 月恐怕機票一位難求乙節,本會已請外交部國際組織司全力協助。

肆、心得、建議及後續工作事項

一、心得

本次委員會議是繼去年我國取得ICA正式會員(Full Member) 後,第1次參加計畫委員會議,意義格外不同。加以今(2011) 年ICA年會由我國舉辦,因此本次會議特別由我國國家代表以及 國家副代表共同出席,以便充分和與會人員交換意見,也顯示我 國對此次舉辦年會之慎重態度。

今年ICA主席、副主席均已換人,從主席Peter Bruce的言談可看 出其對於ICA組織擴展的雄心。而我國主動提出於ICA 45年會邀 請中國大陸學者演講,亦充分表現出資訊技術無疆界的合作精 神。

二、建議

- 持續分享我國推動民眾參與公共事務之經驗,積極推動和其他國家的分享。
- 2. 建議後續可結合 ICA 45 年會與本會或其他機關辦理之其他資 訊相關研討會,以發揮本次會議之最大效益。
