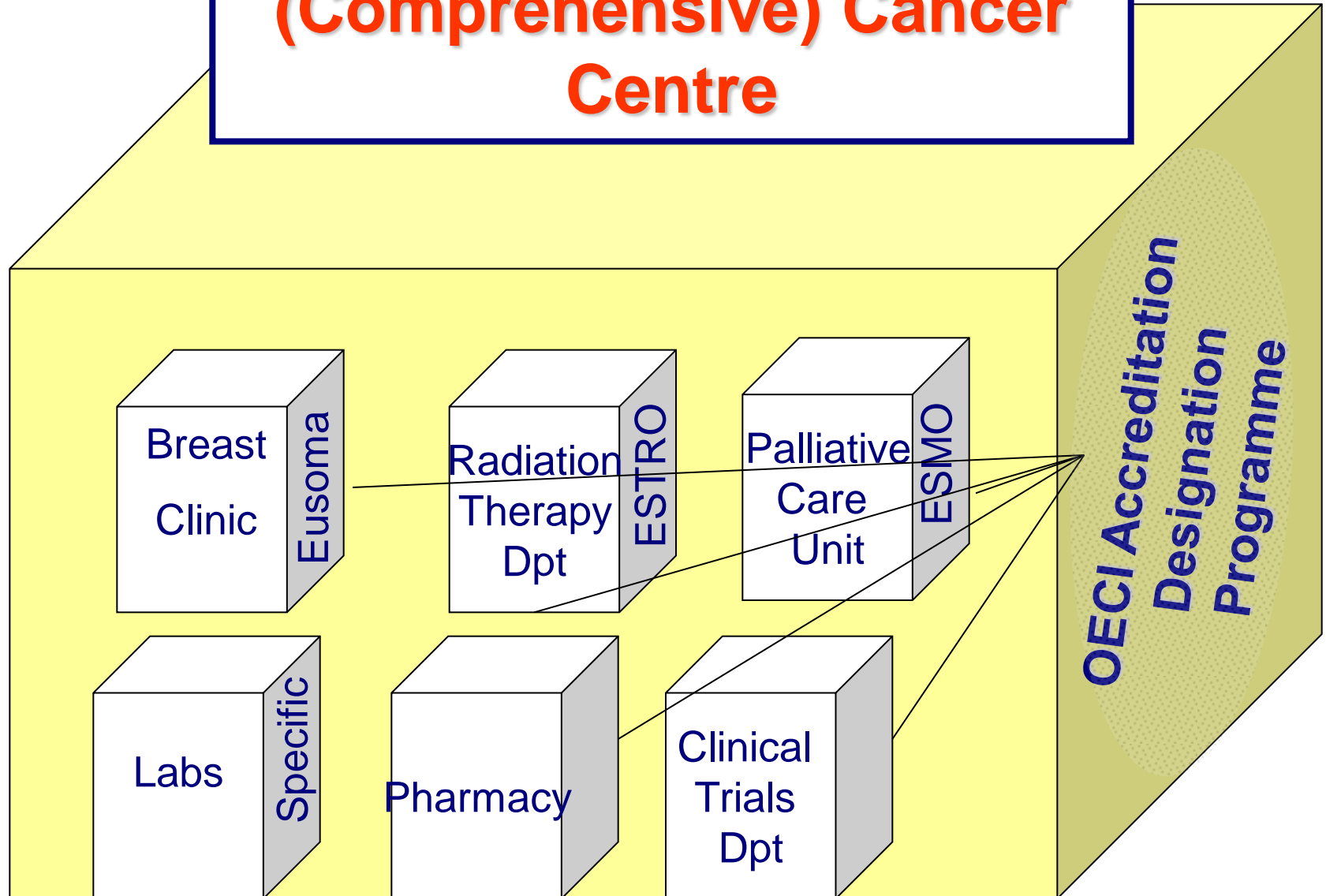


Aims of the accreditation process

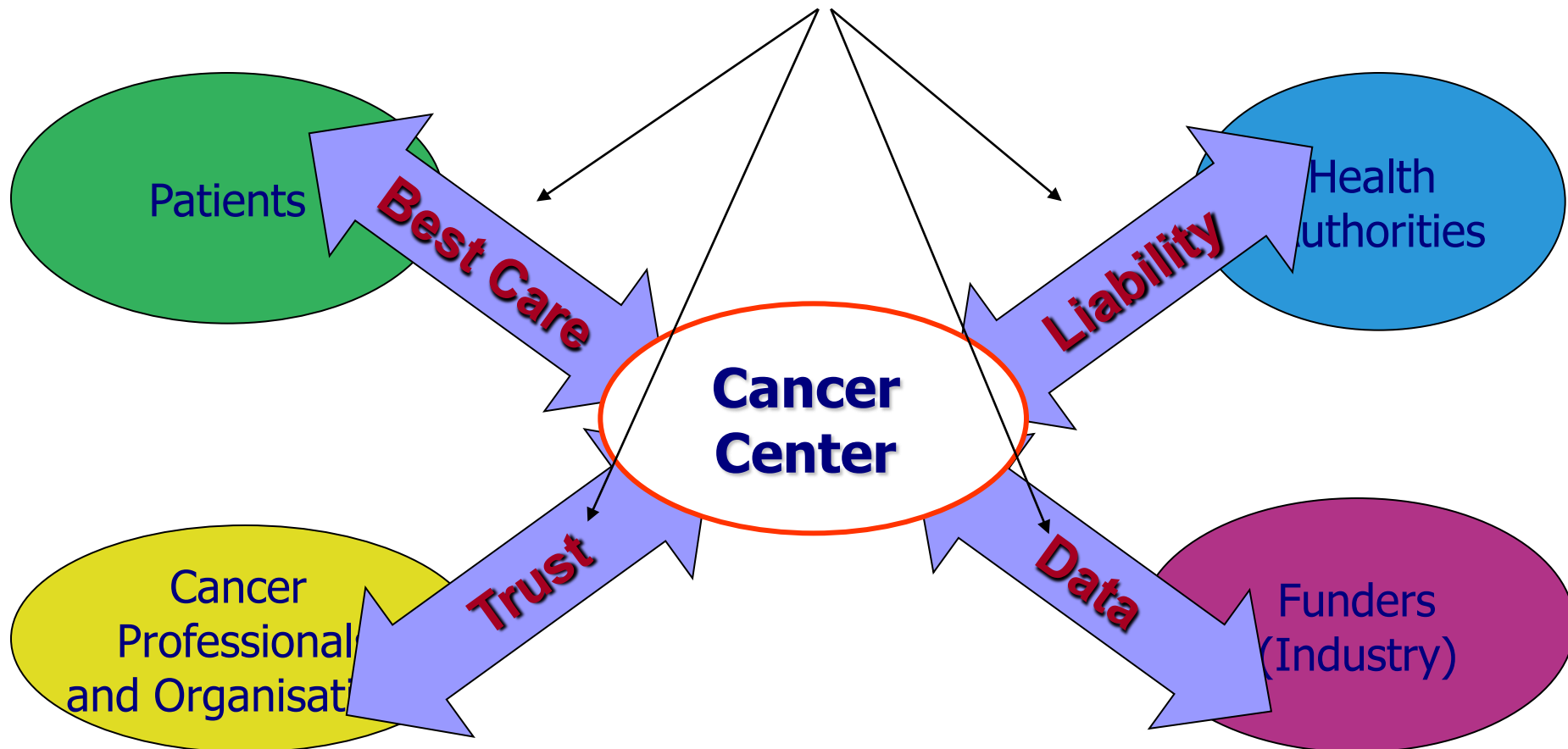
To examine in a (cancer) centre

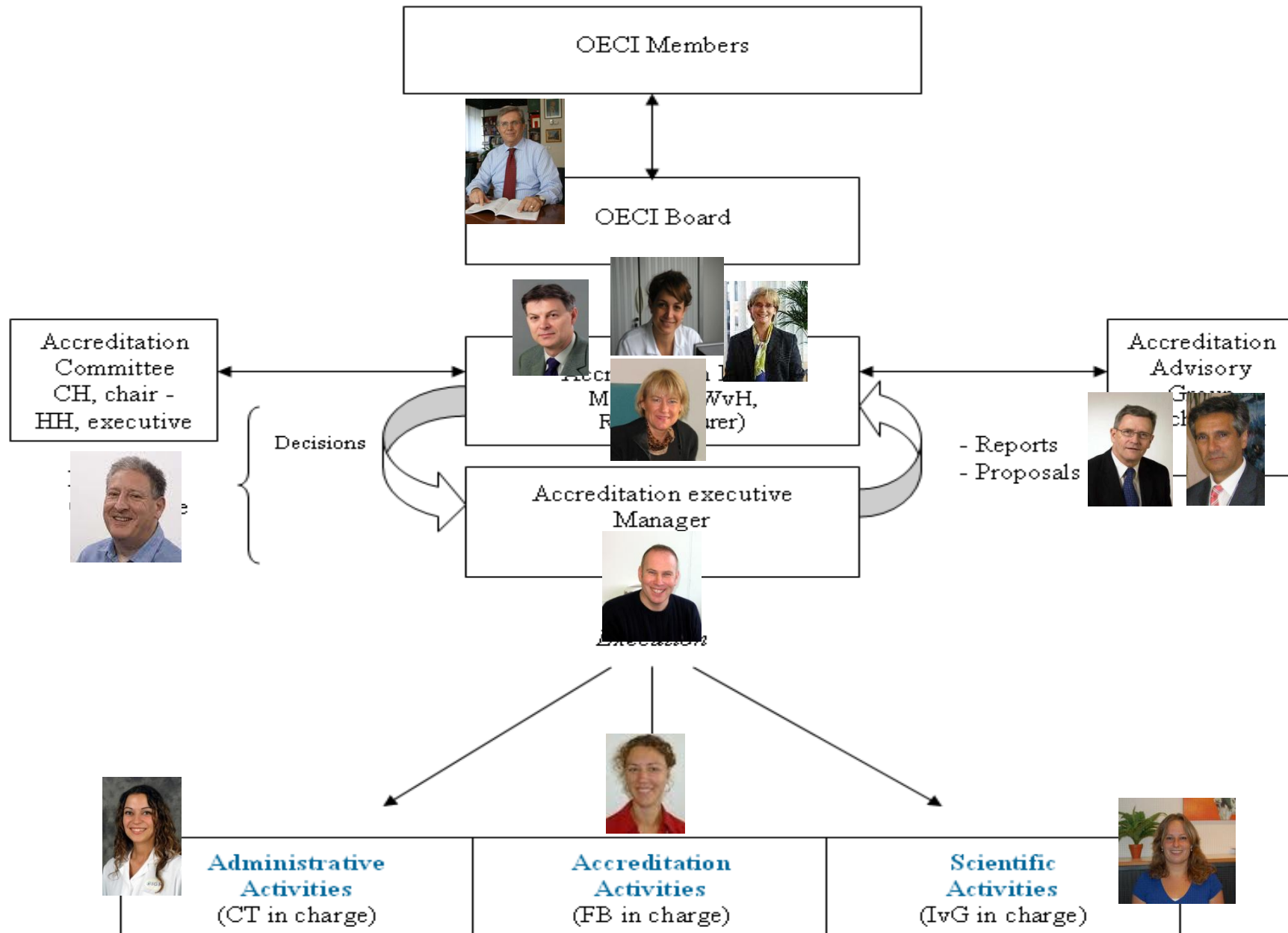
- if the organization and its quality system meets OECI standards

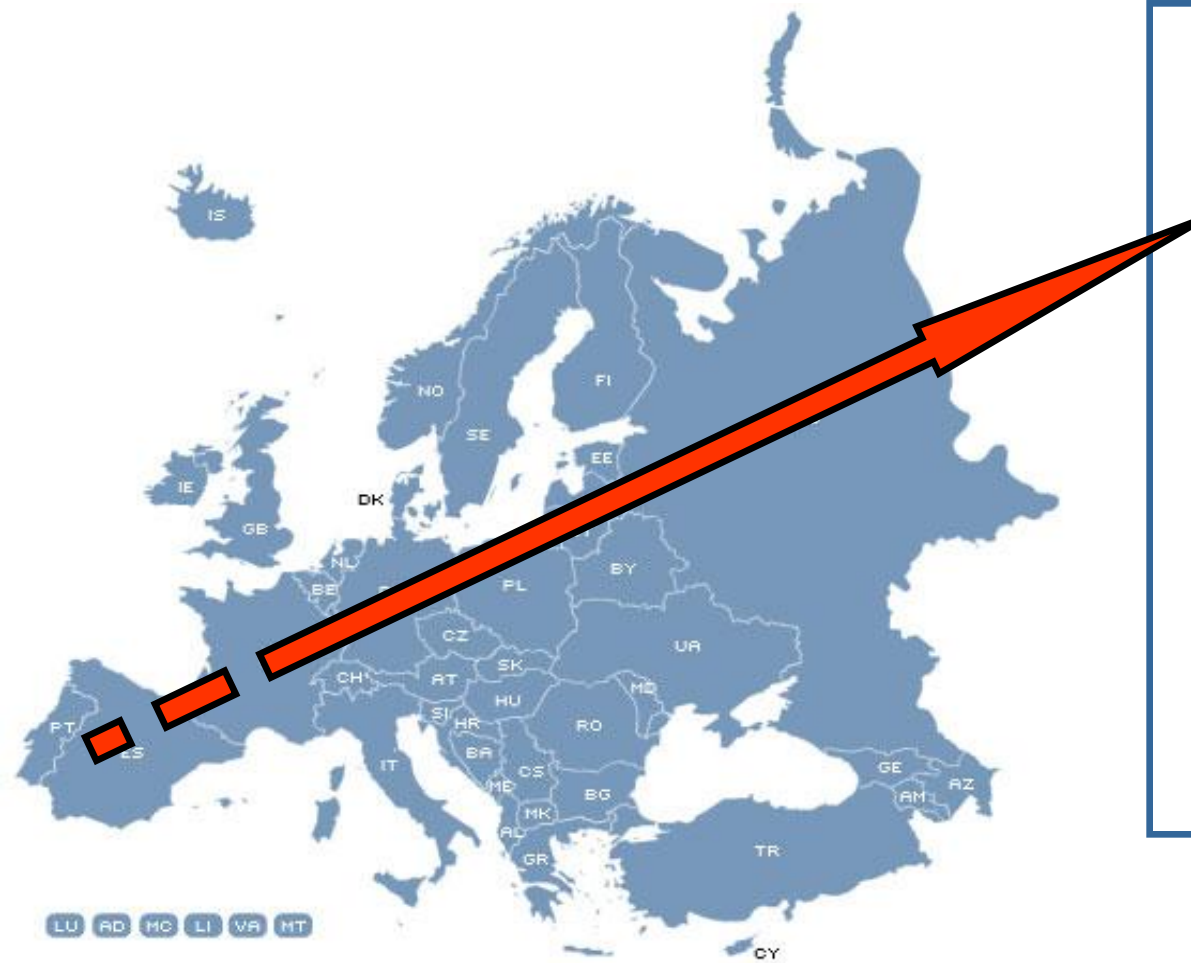

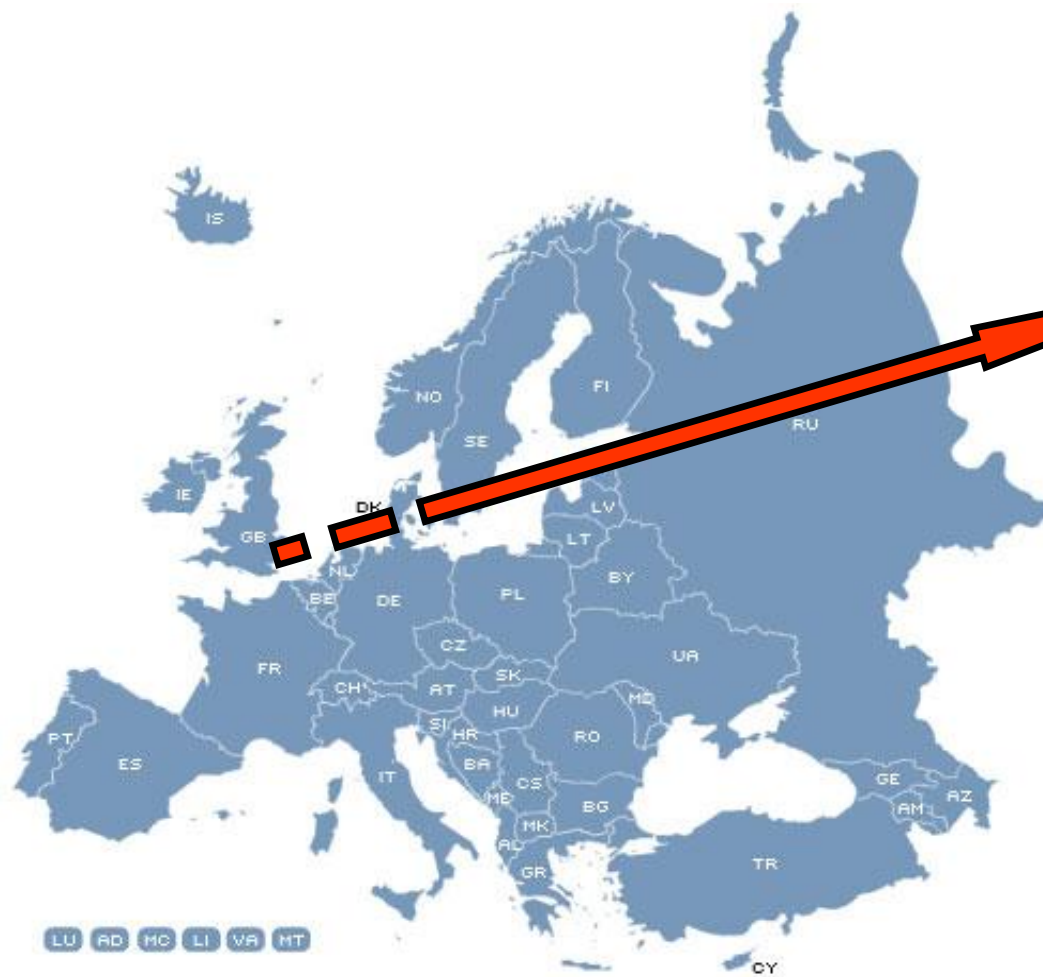

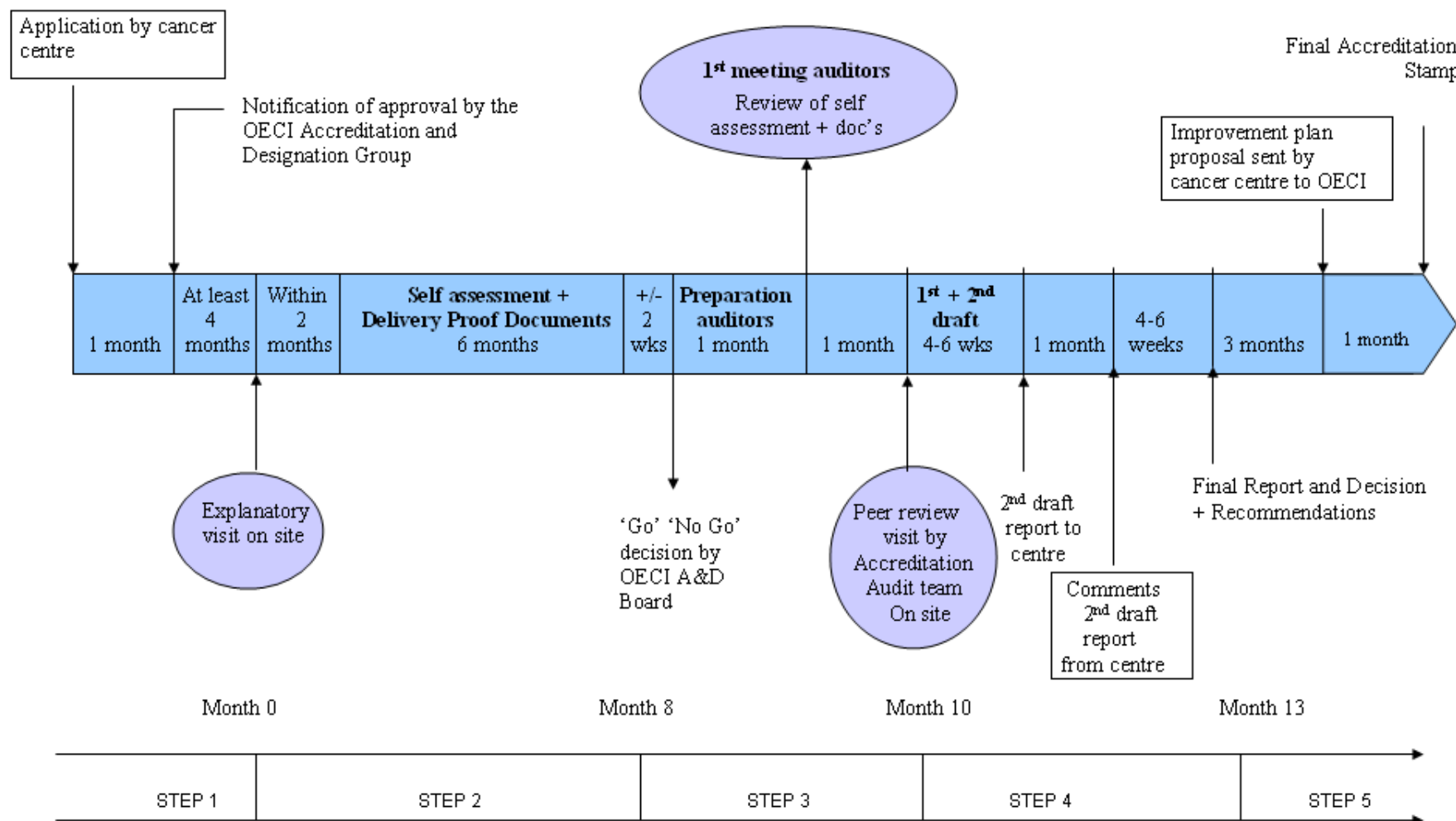

Explanatory visit : T0

- Presentation by OECCI staff : ½ day
- Participation of staff from centre required
 - Board members
 - Quality team
 - Local coordinator
 - Head of departments
- Agreement on timelines
- Questions

Self assessment: 6 months

- Answer questions in e-tool
- Gather proof documents
- Involvement of ALL staff
- Coordination : 1 local coordinator in charge
- Organisation ++
- Scheduling

Peer Review Visit: Month 10

- 2 full days on site
- Availability ++
- Tight Agenda
- Tours / interviews / presentations
- Preliminary summary report
- Main language = English
- Translator must be available
