### Courses planned for 2012

n A case study and workshop that examines significant recent improvements in the measurement and custody transfer of bunker fuel in Singapore.

n Scheduled for March 2012



## Courses planned for 2012

n A "train-the-trainer" course on verification of in-line (pipe line) turbine or positive displacement metering systems used for hydrocarbon products in the bulk fuel supply chain.

n Scheduled for Thailand Mid 2012



### Regional Test Procedures

- n Chair of each WG agreed to examine test procedures used by Australia for NAWI
- n Canada provided an in-depth report outlining the differences. The language was different. MC has not adopted OIML R 76.
- n Useful exercise to identify differences in in testing NAWI within the region.



## Next APEC Application for Funding

- n Request sent to each economy which produced a very wide range of proposals from only 4 economies
- n A further attempt was made to refine the request by asking all economies to choose from this list.
- n 1 reply received from Thailand
- n Secretariat needs direction regarding topic, host and trainers



## **APEC Funding proposal**

### n Key ideas

- Ø Relevance what is the benefit to the stakeholders
- ØEffectiveness how is the design cost effective
- Importance must meet a priority area
- ØAlternate approaches we look like we repeat the same thing over and over



### Suggestions

- n Study tours
- n Commission a report to measure the degree of implementation of OIML recommendations within the region
- n Develop process that make economies and course participants more accountable for implementing change as a result of attending training courses



### Suggestions

- n Invite local industry to attend training for a fee
- n Secretariat to monitor implementation by following up after 6 and 12 month intervals.

- n Completed concept note required as step 1 need to answer these key?
  - What does the project seek to achieve?
  - ØHow does the project meet the priorities of APLMF and APEC?
  - Why should APEC undertake this project?
  - ØHow do you plan to implement this project?



### **APEC Criteria**

- n Relevance Why is it important
- n Objectives 2 or 3
- n Alignment How will it achieve APEC priorities?
- n Work Plan timeline
- n Risks identify and manage
- n Monitoring and evaluation set indicators that measure the success



### **APEC Criteria**

- n Budget set out costs
- n Cost efficiency does the plan maximise value for money?
- n Beneficiary identify who will benefit
- n Gender ensure engagement of both men and women
- n Sustainability describe impact into the future
