## **ICANN Milestones 2012 Proposed GAC Processes** (see also 'Questions and potential issues for the GAC') Jan •12th: Applications Open Feb New gTLD Advice & Early Warning Periods open (early May – June 2011) Mar •11<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>: ICANN San Jose •ICANN notifies GAC that the new gTLD GAC Advice & Early Warning Periods have started and emails the list of strings, and a link to applications to a nominated GAC contact •GAC members email any Early Warnings to the GAC list, on an agreed template •GAC Secretariat monitors emails and maintains a list of strings that are subject to Early Warnings Apr •12th: Applications Close Internal GAC deadline for Early Warnings (before ICANN Prague) •1st: ICANN Posts Complete Applications\* May •GAC members provide Early Warnings to secretariat by no later than 18 June to allow collation •1st: GAC Early Warning/Advice Period Opens\* prior to ICANN Prague • Secretariat emails GAC list with all Early Warnings received, grouping together those that apply to the same string and/or applicant (if relevant) •12th: Administration Completeness Check Finishes\* Jun •24th -29th: ICANN Prague •29th: GAC Early Warning Period Closes\* GAC issues Early Warnings (ICANN Prague) GAC sends Early Warnings in agreed format to agreed ICANN point of contact (authentication issue) Jul •20th: Deadline for applicants to respond to GAC Early Warnings\* Developing GAC advice (July - October) Aug •ICANN advises GAC of the status of applications that were the subject of Early Warnings (i.e. did any withdraw?) (24 July\*) Secretariat compiles a list of any applications subject to Early Warnings that have not been withdrawn, and emails it to the GAC with a request for volunteers (string leads) to progress Sept intersessional work (26 July\*, volunteers notify GAC by 1 August\*) String leads seek information on the positions of GAC members (6-20 August\*) •String leads summarise GAC member positions on each contentious string in background papers and provide to GAC no later than 4 weeks before ICANN Toronto to allow GAC members to obtain necessary clearance for national positions (by 14 September) Oct •14th-19th: ICANN Toronto Finalising GAC advice (ICANN Toronto) Nov •30th: GAC Advice Period Closes\* GAC seeks consensus advice on contentious strings Chair provides GAC advice to the ICANN Board Dec
