- Policies and Guidelines:
 - RFC 1591
 - ICP 1
 - GAC Principles 2005
- Exhaustive review of IANA delegation/redelegation reports
- Findings: lack of transparency and significant inconsistencies in IANA's application of policies and guidelines to requests for delegation and redelegation of ccTLDs.

Framework of Interpretation Working Group

- Chartered in March 2011 to develop an overall framework for interpreting those policies and guidelines
- No changes to existing policy, no new policy
 - May recommend policy development if gaps are identified
- IANA functions contract out of scope
 - ccNSO comments on FNOI

Topics

- 1. "Consent" meaning and requirements
- 2. The definition of "significantly interested parties" and processes and procedures for securing their input
- 3. Change of managers in the absence of the incumbent manager's consent
- Creation of a comprehensive glossary for terms used in the policies and principles documents.
- 5. Identification of standard information to be included in IANA reports

Consideration Cycles

- Topic by topic
- Interim topic report
- Public consultation on the interim topic report
- Final topic report reflecting public comments
- Formal consideration of the final topic report by the ccNSO and the GAC.

Operations

- Meeting (by teleconference) once every two weeks
 - 9 meetings since Singapore
 - All meetings open
- No issue resolved during a single call
- 2 year timeline
