摘要

本人於 2011 年 10 月 17~22 日至北京中國社會科學院語言研究所進行學術交流，並參加該單位所舉辦之國際語言學會議 *International Symposium on the Interfaces of Grammar*，受邀發表題為 "A Tale of Two Peripheries: Evidence from Chinese adverbials, light verbs, applicatives and object fronting" 之論文，並擔任大會總結 Open Forum 之主持人。

本次會議以語法模組(grammatical modules)的介面研究為主題，並從比較語法(comparative grammar)的角度來廣泛考察介面理論(interface theories)對語言共性與特性研究的啟發與貢獻。此外，會議論文未來結集後將與歐美知名出版社聯繫，正式簽約出版。與會學者來自美國、法國、荷蘭、匈牙利、瑞典、日本、中國大陸、香港、臺灣等地，加上聽眾共一百餘人，對相關議題之交流討論相當熱烈。

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一、目的

10月19日參加為期三天的會議。本次會議以語法模組(*grammatical modules*)的介面研究為主題，並從比較語法(*comparative grammar*)的角度來廣泛考察介面理論(*interface theories*)對語言共性與特性研究的啟發與貢獻。此外，會議論文未來結集後將與歐美知名出版社聯繫，正式簽約出版。與會學者來自美國、法國、荷蘭、匈牙利、瑞典、日本、中國大陸、香港、臺灣等地，加上聽眾共一百餘人，對相關議題之交流討論相當熱烈。
