





- Affordable price




### Taiwan's outstanding medical care quality



- According to the Worldwide Health Rankings of the Economist Intelligence Unit in 2000, Taiwan ranks second, only after Sweden.
- In 2003, ABC News in the US reported about Taiwan's National Health Insurance and medical care integrity under the heading "Health Utopia".

### Taiwan's outstanding medical care quality



- In the IMD global competitiveness ranking in 2007, Taiwan's healthcare infrastructure ranks 13th (a total of 55 countries were ranked).
- A Nobel Prize winner, economist Paul Krugman, has said publicly that Taiwan's health insurance system is the best in the world.
- According to the "Quality of Death" survey conducted by the "Lien Foundation" in Singapore in 2010, Taiwan ranks 14th (a total of 40 countries were ranked).

# The character of medical service

#### Advanced medical care

- Patient search for cure or better health condition
- High professionalism required, high marginal economic effect, stable client size.
- Treatment: facial cranial reconstruction, organ transplant, cardiovascular therapy, assisted reproductive therapy, joint replacement, etc.


#### Medical tourism

- Travel and relaxation oriented.
- Low professional and high city marketing required, wide potential client size.
- Treatment: plastic surgery, laser cosmetic surgery, physical check-up, spa treatment, etc.





### Assured medical care quality-Hospital accreditation system



- In addition to the USA, Canada, and Australia, Taiwan is the fourth country implementing a hospital accreditation system.
- The Taiwan Joint Commission on Hospital Accreditation in 2006 gained International Society for Quality in Healthcare (ISQua) certification. It is the 1st institution in Asia and the 8th in the world to gain certification.
- Many hospitals have gained JCI international accreditation.





#### **Weaknesses**

- Complicated visa application procedures for people from Mainland China may affect their desire to go to Taiwan.
- Lack of comprehensive marketing channels.
- Foreigners are not familiar with medical care standards and system, and the actual circumstances in Taiwan.


#### **Opportunities**

- Decreased cross Strait tension and increased international traveling traffics.
- Hospitals and travel agencies are interested in this field.
- More foreign white-collar workers in Taiwan

#### **Threats**

- Singapore, Thailand and India have long been working in this field.
- Cultural and legal differences tend to be a concern for cross-border medical care.
- Political sensitivity across the Taiwan Strait may have an impact.






