








#### **Peru in Numbers**



### Peruvian Single Window Background

- The National Strategic Export Plan (2003-2013): Trade
   Facilitation measures
- The Foreign Trade Agreements
- Competitiveness
- The government has a strong will to develop and operate the paperless trade system from the national level
- Spanish acronym: VUCE





### **Peruvian Single Window Definition**

"VUCE is an integrated system that allows all parties involved in trade and transport to lodge documents and information for fulfill import, transit and export- related regulatory requirements, by electronic means."

Article 2° of Decree Law N° 1036





#### Components

Controlled Goods

Allow users through the system to obtain all permits, certificates, licenses and required authorization for the import/export of controlled goods

Port Services Allow users through the system to obtain permits, licenses and required to the arrival and departure of a ship

Origin

Allow users through the system to obtain origin certificates




### **Single Window Vision**



Many complex Forms






Too many steps to get a permit



#### **Difficulties & countermeasures**

Ambiguous rules related to trade requirements





### **Good practices**

- Governance, special commission: Private and Public sector
- Legal Framework
- Unique process to obtain all permits
- Infrastructure investment inside public institutions
- Interconnection using dedicate line with public institutions to improve network speed
- Use of standards
- Interoperability with private companies
- Learn from others





#### **Lessons Learned**

- Political will is stronger if VUCE is presented as a nation's policy
- Human resources coaching for transition period. Forced measures bring resistance
- Private sector involvement will legitimate change. Specially in implementation stage
- Be rigorous in devising the master plan and architecture but get ready for flexibility





### **Next steps**

- Interoperability with customs clearance
- Addition of 11 new public agencies, 100 administrative procedures.
- Interoperability with other SW
- Deployment of Origin Component
- Deployment of Port Services
- Risk Management in all public agencies involved in foreign trade
- Capacity improvement
