- Founded in 1994
- Division under Chung Hwa Nuclear Society
- National members: 158 Global members: 48
- Steering and Advisory Committee meets every 2~3 months; workgroup meetings
- President/Vice President: 2012~2014

## Nuclear Facilities in Taiwan

- Nuclear Power Plants and Performance
  - Number of reactors in operation: 6
  - Share of electricity from nuclear in 2012: 16.1%
  - Average capacity factor in 2012: 89.9%
  - Number of reactors under construction: 2
  - None in decommissioning phase
- Research Reactors
  - Tsing Hua University Open-pool Reactor (THOR)

## Waste Management

- Repository for L&IL waste – site selection
  - Two recommended candidate sites selected
  - County referendum required
  - Law to be amended to streamline process
- Repository for HL waste – host rock investigation
  - Drilling in Hualien halted 2012
  - Research in Kingmen interrupted 2013
  - PA issues – More communication needed
