General (Clause 4.7.1)

At planned intervals, top management shall review organization's EnMS to sure its continuing **suitability**, **adequacy** and **effectiveness**.

Records of management review shall be maintained.

Input to management review (Cl. 4.7.2)

Input shall include,

- · Follow up actions from previous reviews
- Review of energy policy
- Review of energy performance and related EnPIs
- Results of evaluation of compliance with requirements
- Extent to which energy objectives are met
- EnMS audit results
- Status of corrective actions and preventive actions
- Projected energy performance
- Recommendations for improvement

Output from management review

(Clause 4.7.3)

Input shall include any **decisions** and **actions**,

- Changes in energy performance of the organization
- · Changes to the energy policy
- Changes to the EnPIs
- Changes to objectives, targets or others
- Changes to allocation of resources
