Effective 1 March 2014




- Combines international technical standards, best practices and consumer experiences

- 3. Sets minimum quality benchmarks for telecommunications services
- 4. Sets performance parameters
- Operators must provide clear and transparent service offerings
- 6. Compliance through reporting and audit
- 7. Breach of the Code attracts financial penalties of up to B\$1 million




International Mobile Roaming




