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California ETS



- State-wide cap on GHG emissions
- Program began in 2013 and runs through 2020
- Three compliance periods

Compliance Period	Coverage
2013 – 2014	Large industrial emitters only
2015 – 2017	85% of economy-wide emissions (including transportation fuels &
2018 – 2020	natural gas distribution)





 Up to 8% of compliance obligation can be fulfilled with offsets


Top-Down Approach = Limited Supply






"Early Action" Pipeline Has Alleviated Some Pressure...

Building Up Administrative Capacity


 Processing of projects has been delegated to third-party registries (like CAR), but regulators have still been slow to approve projects (especially early action)

Invalidation Risk and Uncertainty

- California offsets can be declared "invalid" if errors are discovered post-issuance
- "Clean Harbors" decision invalidated 88,955 ODS credits based on permitting violations at Arkansas destruction facility (out of 4 million initially scrutinized)

Looking Forward...



- Lenient initial caps have created some breathing room
- Floor price is maintaining some incentive for current project developers
- But offset credit shortages loom without further action by California regulators...
 - Building administrative capacity and removing backlogs
 - Providing clearer and more timely guidance on invalidation risk and protocol requirements
 - Adopting new protocols for additional project types
 - Including international offsets
