Within public sector


Eradication of improper solicitation + Prohibition of acceptance of bribes





Prohibition of graft

Criteria for sanctions against the acceptance of money or gifts by a public official or his/her spouse





Types of improper solicitations

15 types of improper solicitations in detail

Report to agencies in charge of public interest whistleblowing
















Achievements since the enactment of the Public Interest Whistleblower Protection Act in 2011






Loopholes of the existing Act







Main contents of the revised bill (1)
