# 摘要

## 壹、 出國目的

本次前往香港第四屆高等教育協會研討會,主要是與來自亞洲地區主要國家的高等教育領域菁英學者,共同研討「亞洲高等教育的公平、就業與人才流動」議題並共同探討相關的學術討論以及學術研究發表的管道。本次會議的主辦單位是香港大學和香港領南大學。與會學者有香港大學教育學院院長 Stephen Andrews、香港嶺南大學莫家豪教授、香港大學楊瑞教授、香港大學李軍教授、南韓首爾國立大學申正徹教授、香港大學 Gerard Postiglione 教授、日本廣島大學 Satoshi Watanabe 教授、日本東北大學米澤彰純教授、香港教育學院盧一威教授、南韓成均館大學 Jang Wan Ko 教授、日本廣島大學 Futao Huang教授、德國 Kassel 大學的 Ulrich Teichler 教授、以及其他來自新加坡、中國大陸重要大學以及研究單位的高等教育學者。




## 參、心得及建議事項

從本次第四屆高等教育協會研討會的主題「亞洲高等教育的公平、就業與人才流動」 議題觀之,研討會顯然將高等教育的就業和人才流動視為重要的問題並且認為和社會以 及教育公平有很高的關連性。本次短期兩天時間與會學者一共發表 29 篇關於上述主題 的研究論文,效率很高是其中的優勢。本次研討會是以「高等教育」為核心,「亞洲」 為基地,交給亞洲不同國家以高等教育研究為主的學院去主辦歷年的會議,運作方式可 供參考。香港大學教育學院主辦方對於邀請發表學者的國家來源多元性很高,邀請發表 學者多為亞洲地區年輕具淺力的高等教育研究學者,會後並規劃場次以及電子郵件群組 來討論後續研究發表出版的管道,值得我國相關領域參考。
