"not designed to impede national space programs or international cooperation in such programs as long as such activities could not contribute to delivery systems for WMD"

1992 All Unmanned Delivery Systems for All WMDs


Others

Adopted "Catch-all" Control (2003)

Contributed to the launch of HCOC (2002)


