- Independent from the High Council of Justice

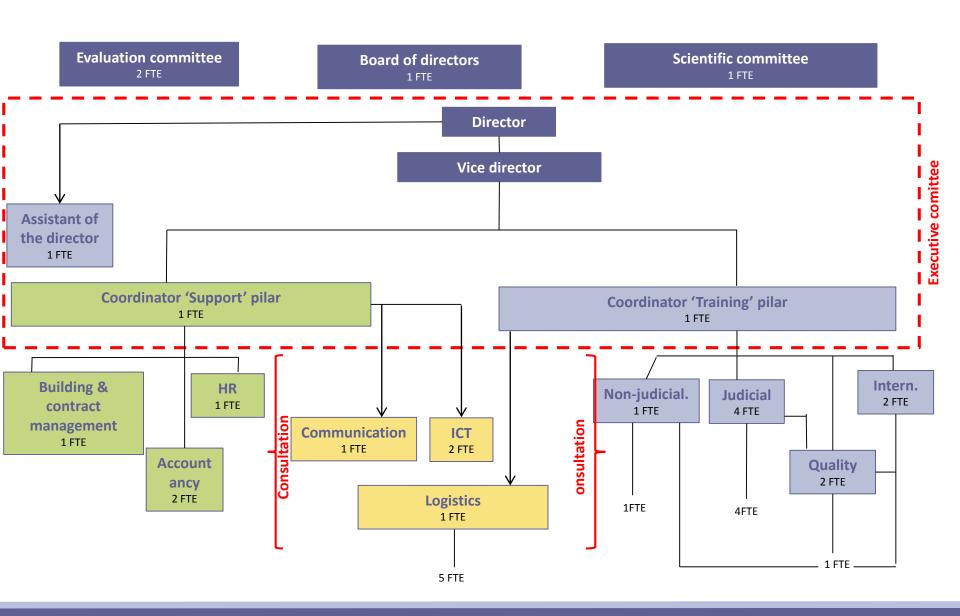
Founded in 2009

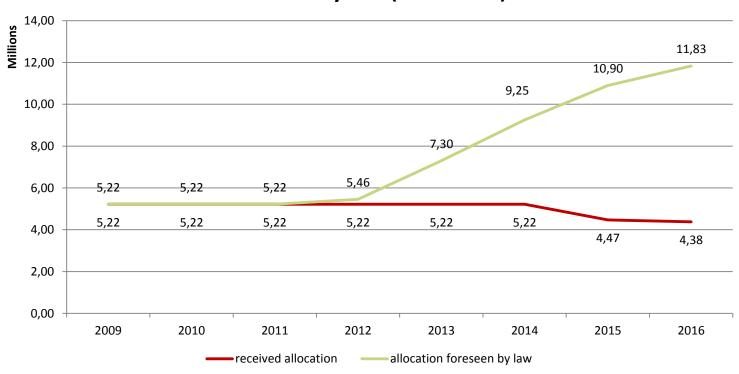

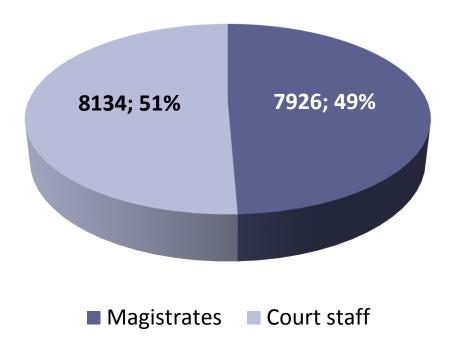
Evolution of the received allocation and the allocation foreseen by law (in millions)

Magistrates and court staff: total 16.060

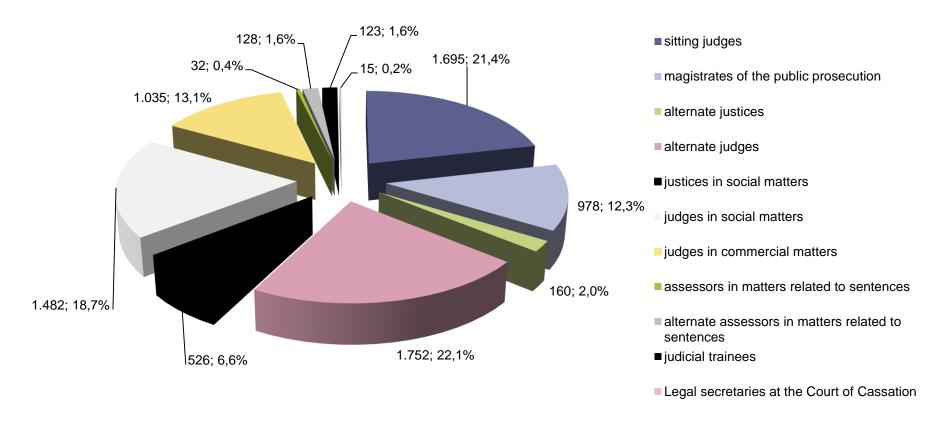

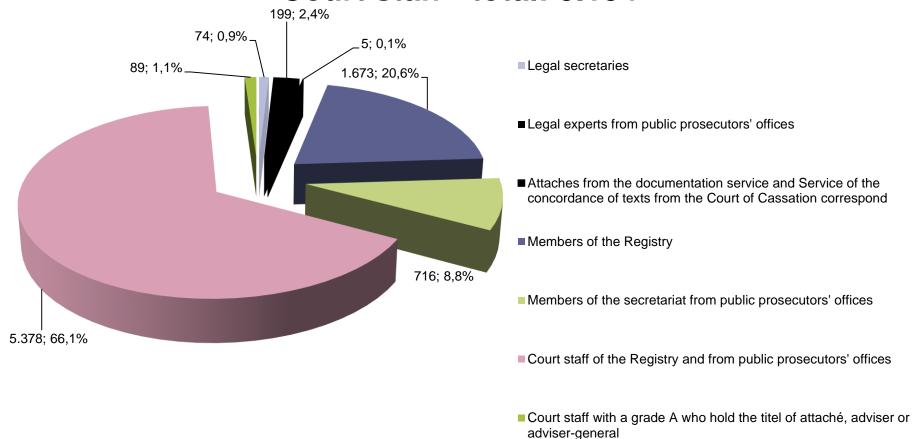

1st year: 15 mandatory training courses:

- Criminal evidence, technical and scientific progress
- Holocaust and human rights
- Weapons legislation
- Budgetary management and legal costs

- Basic training on physical injuries

6. Training offer: judicial trainees (4)

New system

Implementation of a uniform judicial traineeship of 2 years

- Enters into force as from 1st October 2017
- Limited to 60 training days
- Transitional period for judicial trainees who already started their traineeship before 1 October 2017

At the JTI, computers are available for training on IT

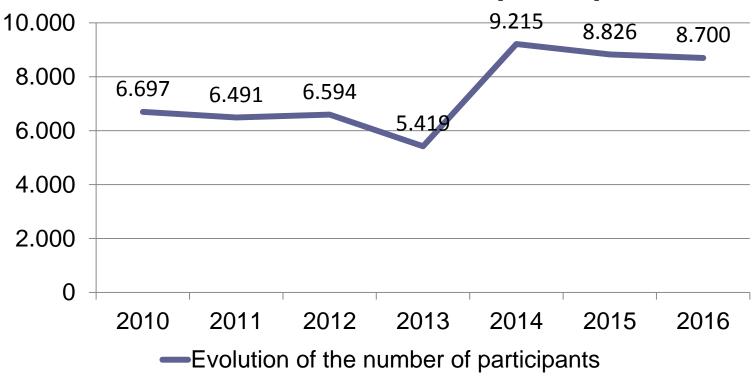

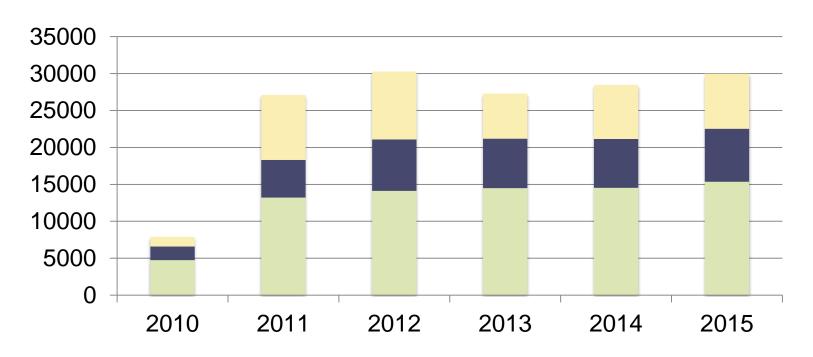
Evolution of the number of participants
