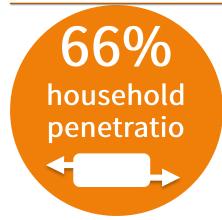

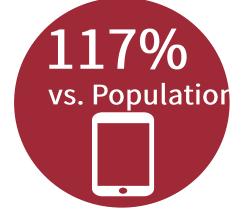




Universal policy
