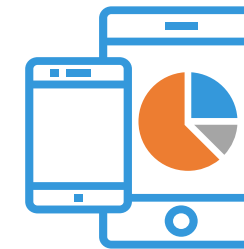


Participants' profile

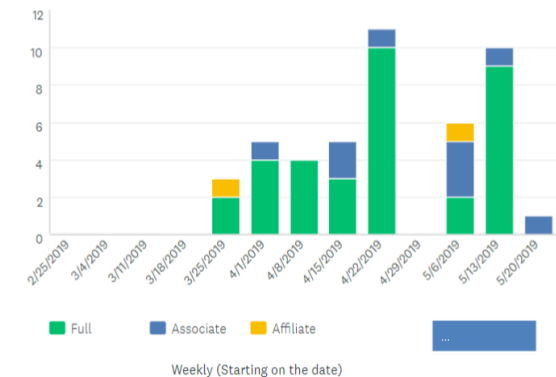

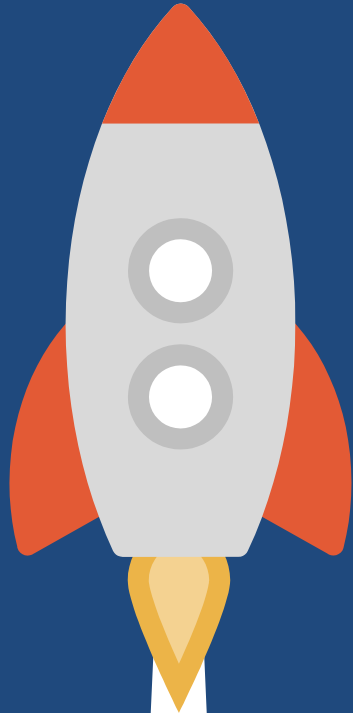

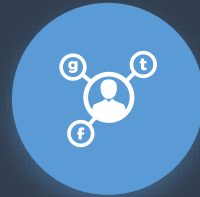
