## (一)目的:

位於大巴黎地區的「巴黎戴高樂和布爾歇機場區域」(Paris CDG & Le Bourget Airport Area)是以戴高樂機場和布爾歇機場為核心 10 英里半徑範圍的區域,密集的路網讓這個區域得以整體發展,也連接巴黎其他重要的商業區。該區域也因此成為了大巴黎地區乃至整個法國的主要商業區。為強化「巴黎戴高樂和布爾歇機場區域」與國際上其他重要機場區域的國際競爭力,2009年,由巴黎機場公司及大巴黎地區企業部門協調,成立大巴黎 Hubstart 地區聯盟(Hubstart Paris Region® Alliance),並開放國際結盟,每年10月輪流於巴黎及國際夥伴機場城市舉辦機場地區永續發展國際研討會。


2017年會議中,包括法國機場周邊區域政府首長、區域內各城鎮官員及代表,以及來自韓國松島、香港、桃園、北京、上海浦東、德黑蘭、達拉斯、赫爾辛基、亞特蘭大國際機場區域開發招商相關政府代表及公司幹部等都出席本次會議。去(2018)年在北京大興機場舉行,今年則於亞特蘭大以大數據應用為會議專題,進行探討。

本公司代表獲邀擔任會議與談人,就大數據應用如何協助機場周

邊觀光議題說明桃園機場及桃園市政府經驗。除經驗分享,互相 學習,並增進桃園機場與國際相關社群之交流,接洽未來合作。

## (二)過程:

本次會議由大巴黎 Hubstart 地區聯盟與美國亞特蘭大航空城公司、亞特蘭大機場公司合辦,邀請了包括來自巴黎、亞特蘭大、北京、維也納、香港、多倫多、赫爾辛基、辛辛那提、阿姆斯特丹等機場或航空城開發公司,顧問機構,地方政府,非營利組織等代表,齊聚一堂,分別以大數據及科技創新對於機場及周邊區域之永續環境、就業及教育、社區發展、觀光發展等面向之影響討論分享。會後並安排三項相關參訪活動。

#### (三)心得與建議

本次會議為各參與國家之機場及周邊區域開發相關單位之年度討 論平台。觀察國際經驗,綜整建議如下:

- 1. 參與新議題之國際合作網絡:各國因制度或開發範圍有所不同, 航空城發展相關業務可能由機場公司負責,或由地方政府辦理, 抑或相關利害關係者(包括機場、中央及地方政府、相關產業等) 合資成立開發公司進行。而機場城市議題近年來已成相關業界重 要共同話題,也是機場爭取業外營收之良機。參與針對新議題發 展之國際網絡,有助發展新業務,尋求商機。會議結束後,部分 與會者於 11 月初來台參加航發會與美國世界飛安基金會(Flight Safety Foundation, FSF)共同舉辦之 2019 世界飛安高峰會,隨即 回訪桃園機場,了解未來合作機會。
- 2. 機場國際交流與城市國際交流相得益彰:歐美國家之機場管理, 地方政府扮演重要角色。在美國,機場由市/郡政府管理;在歐 洲,機場公司則由地方政府部分持股。機場城市建設為國際所關 注時,機場與城市攜手合作,進行國際行銷,效益則能倍增。本 次會議舉辦前夕,部分與會者即進行相關聯盟備忘錄簽署;包括 北京大興機場航空城公司與亞特蘭大航空城公司,巴黎機場公司 與亞特蘭大機場公司,以及亞特蘭大市與大巴黎 Hubstart 地區聯 盟(續約),都藉著會議之便,進行合作簽署儀式。本次與會,亦 與亞特蘭大機場公司人員洽談未來簽署合作備忘錄相關事宜。亞 特蘭大市與台北市已締結姊妹市,所屬之富頓郡則為桃園市之姊 妹市;同為機場城市,並致力於開發航空城,未來以機場及相關 發展議題,深化交流。








Tourism in Taiwan (2018)


