Access to Congested Airports Task Force

Achievements

- Enhancements to the rules for access to congested airports that will allow more operators to benefit from a larger access to the slots pool:
 - Changes to the primary criteria for initial slot allocation of historic slots. (WSG10)
 - Changes to the New Entrant definition from 5 to 7 slots at that airport on that day. (WSG10)
 - Clarifying the additional criteria for slot allocation (new WASG)
- Provisions to providing coordinators with information about airlines' and airports' business priorities and development plans reinforcing transparency. (WSG10)
- Provisions for communication of slot allocation data after SAL (WSG 9)



Airport Levels Task Force

Achievements

- Improvements to the airport demand analysis process with additional clarity of the roles of airports and coordinators
- New section on the capacity declaration, timelines for communication of coordination parameters
- Simulation test of the Enhanced Level 2 Airport concept
- Best practice guidelines for airport designation.
- Review of the airport levels naming convention.



Historic Determination Task Force

Achievements

- Analysis and evaluation of series length and the 80/20 rule
- Analysis of pre and post HBD utilization, the factors that impact schedule planning throughout this period and the return of slots
- Trial of early Series Return Deadline (ongoing)



Slot Performance Monitoring Task Force


Achievements

Better understanding by airports of the airline and coordinator processes related to slot monitoring


- New and enhanced slot performance monitoring standards (WSG10):
 - New chapter 9 of the WSG describing slot monitoring and its key principles
 - Definition of slot misuse
 - Introduction of pre-operation and post-operation analysis
 - Enforcement actions
 - Enhanced objectives and principles of the Coordination and Slot Performance Committees
 - Best practice guidelines for data analysis




New Governance at a Glance
