

## Methods and policy for marine debris monitoring and distribution means

AFD understanding



- Loan to government to support acquisition of scientific tools (satellite data, ocean research vessels, sensors...) to have adequate means to implement methods,
- Support peer-to-peer exchange
- Support capacity buildings: tree

Tools to provide Evidence-based policies

Policy: regulatory framework, stakeholders, implementation, adequate budget and responsabilities

- DPL through supporting the government reforms to reach their targets,
- o Studies to look at the reforms needed, drawbacks of some policies if any, transition risks,
- Support on budget tagging including capacity buidlings,

# Methods and policy for marine debris monitoring and distribution means

AFD understanding



- o when does a debris starts to be marine related?
- o If mismanaged any kind of waste is likely to become a marine debris within a more or less long time period,
- Monitoring: follow-up of project regularly, quality assessment
  - o requires to have a baseline
  - o adequate budgeting to ensure sustainability of the monitoring
- Distribution: geographic, seasonal, community related and also policy related (especially when it is local policies)

### WHAT IS THE CLEAN OCEANS INITIATIVE?

The initiative identifies projects that fight plastic waste in rivers, seas and on land. The goal is to finance €2 billion in public and private sector projects by 2023. The initiative has already met more than a third of this target.

The focus is on regular waste, wastewater and stormwater management projects that reduce the discharge of plastics and other waste. To be eligible, projects need to demonstrate efficient and effective ways of stopping plastic waste.

The initiative was launched in October 2018 by the Agence Française de Développement (AFD), the European Investment Bank and KfW, the German promotional bank

### WE ARE TARGETING PROJECTS IN THESE FIELDS:

- Collection, treatment, recycling and disposal of plastics and other waste from rivers and coastal areas.
- Improved waste management to reduce plastics and other waste in
- Innovative projects that keep plastics out of the oceans or develop reusable or biodegradable plastics.
- Expanding and improving wastewater collection and treatment to keep plastics out of rivers and oceans.
- Urban stormwater management systems that prevent waste and plastics from entering waterways during rains and floods.

### National Maritime Park of Mohéli – Comores

- ⇒ Grants 3 M EUR AFD and 0,2 MEUR FFEM
- ⇒ Management public/civil society with 10 villages located within the terrestrial boundaries of the park
- $\Rightarrow$  Funds from the NMPM

BACOMAB – Coastal and Marine biodiversity of Arguin Bank – Mauritania

⇒ Grant 2,5 M EUR AFD and 1M EUR FFEM ⇒ Mauritania inputs

- Active participation in UN ESCAPE (Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific): "Promoting economic, social and environmental cooperation on oceans for sustainable development"
  - o to strengthen regional cooperation on the conservation and sustainable use of the oceans, seas and marine resources and on tackling air pollution challenges (ESCAP resolutions 72/9 and 75/4).
  - Side events on air pollution and marine litter and microplastics in coordination with French embassies (Bangkok, Vietnam), IRD, IRASEC, AFD and UNESCAPE

# Indeso Project (2012-2017):


- oceanographic model and pilot operations to fight IUU, oil-spill, mangrove and coral monitoring as well as aquaculture (shrimps and seaweed)
- Is used as the basis to build upon marine debris tracking surveilliance system thanks to the drifting module enhanced to provide simulation and modeling of marine debris trajectories (as seen on the visit of the 19/02/2020)



### In Indonesia

Providing tools for making evidence-based policies:

- Marine Debris monitoring and modeling (2020-2021)
  - 1 Establish a "pilot project" at the Indonesian level to set up a marine debris monitoring system;
    - deployment of floating state-of-the-art GPS sensors replicating the properties of marine debris in Indonesia.
    - This monitoring (live visualization via a web platform) will be carried out in selected pilot areas



→ strengthen the linkage and information exchange practices between the central and local governments on minimizing the risks associated with marine litter.

### Marine research vessels (under appraisal)

- Finance the acquisition of marine research vessel and a retrofit with scientific tools.
- 4 scenarios: 1 Geosciences and geohazard, 2 - fish stock assessment, 3 - 2 Marine Chemistry, Marine Biology and Physics and Atmospheric Sciences and 4 - Hydrography
- Able to do collection of fish, water samples, plastic collection in order to provide evidence

# DPL Logistics (2015-2019), with World Bank

- Government reforms in the sector of sea transportation in order to improve the logistics in connectivity harbor for better efficiency
- Workshops on green harbor labelling including waste management standards with the port authorities, peer exchange between french and indonesian government

### In Indonesia

Implementing projects

- Sustainable and efficient fishing ports (under identification)
  - Willingness of the Government of Indonesia to improve some harbor infrastructure, including activities on traçability, export added value and environmental impact improvement,
  - At the moment: Waste management is done through various means, and open-air incineration seems to be the most common way to deal with the wastes: having impacts on health, hygienes and environment

    - Improved waste and water management




- Ecoquartier

# France actions for tackling the marine debris issue

Few laws against marine debris





June 2015; no more oxofragmentable plastic bags, July 2016: single use plastic banned.

January 2018: ban of cosmetics with tiny bits of plastics (for exfoliation)

January 2020: ban of single use plastic cutlery, glass and plates, January 2020: ban of earbuds
