

STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT: CFA

Puffing Billy Railway (PBR) have a strong partnership with the local CFA Brigades and the communication is strong. Each year we invite them to Puffing Billy Railway for:

- A CFA Familiarisation Train to ascertain clear access to all areas of track by Emergency Services
- A Fire Season brief
- Internal PBR Fire Patroller's Training Course
- Incident Control Centre (ICC) pre-season planning

The last ICC meeting has engaged us with the Upper Ferntree Gully Station Master, who we have been working with for advanced warning systems when we close the Railway.


