
In 2023, China has taken important initiatives and activities supporting the APEC Implementation Plan for the Food Security Roadmap Towards 2030

APEC Workshop on Digital Agriculture Cooperation for Ensuring Food Security;




APEC Workshop on Digital Agriculture Cooperation for Ensuring Food Security

- Date: July 17th-18th, 2023
- Co-sponsor: Thailand, Malaysia
- Organizer: Institute of Agricultural Resources and Regional Planning, CAAS
- More than 100 representatives from government department, research universities, and private companies of 10 APEC economies, including Australia, Canada, China, Malaysia, Mexico, Peru, the Philippines, Russia, Chinese Taipei, and Thailand attended the meeting



APEC Workshop on Digital Agriculture Cooperation for Ensuring Food Security

- This workshop invited 16 experts from Australia, China, Malaysia, Mexico, the
 Philippines, Thailand to give academic reports
- The reports mainly focuses on topics such as agricultural digitalization, smart agriculture, digital monitoring of carbon emissions, application of crop growth models, and typical cases of digital agriculture in APEC member economies
- During the meeting, the report experts had academic interaction with the online participants and discussed related issues



APEC Workshop on Green Control of Critical Crop Diseases for Ensuring Food Security

- Date: July 19th-20th, 2023
- Co-sponsor: Malaysia
- Organizer: Institute of Plant Protection, CAAS
- More than 100 representatives from government department and research universities of 7 APEC member economies, including China, Malaysia, Mexico, Peru, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam attended the meeting. Moreover, some scholars from non-APEC members Egypt and Myanmar attended the meeting



APEC Workshop on Green Control of Critical Crop Diseases for Ensuring Food Security

- This workshop invited 19 experts in the field of green prevention and control of plant diseases to give academic reports
- The reports mainly focuses on topics such as the important mechanism of plant immunity and pathogen pathogenicity, occurrence and damage of diseases, crop disease resistance strategies, and comprehensive disease prevention and control strategies in APEC member economies
- This workshop effectively promoting deep exchanges and cooperation among APEC member economies in green prevention and control of crop diseases
